- 2. The Principal Secretary (Agriculture), Gujarat State at the outset welcomed the committee members.
- 3. With the permission of Chairman, Principal Secretary (Agri.) initiated the meeting and briefly discussed about the objectives of the meeting and Salient Features of the new guideline of RKVY for 12th Five Year Plan as circulated by the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India.

Shri Bhushan, Jt. Secretary, GOI pointed out that the project "Maintence of exisiting Gopal Mitra Centers" cannot be taken under RKVY. Principal Secretary (Agri) said that the project "Maintence of exciting Gopal Mitra Centers" already proposed for being dropped in this SLSC Agenda.

- 4. Chief Secretary has put to the notice of Joint Secretary (RKVY),Gol regarding difficulties in implementing projects without staff and vehicles. 1 percent contingency is not sufficient to execute the projects.
- 5. After initial remarks by Principal Secretary (Agri.), Joint Director of Agriculture (RKVY) took up agenda wise discussions.

commentswere received from the members, the committee has

7. Agenda-2: Action Taken Report

- 1. As per decision taken during 11th SLSC, all Continuous & New projects were categorized as "production Growth" and "Infrastructure & Assets"
- 2. For Preparation of State Agriculture Plan (SAP) & State Agriculture Infrastructure development Plan (SAIDP), Sector wise sub-committees were formed & asked sub-committees to submit the report within one month.

Nodal Officer and Vice Chancellor of Anand Agriculture University has assured committee that SAP and SAIDP will be prepared up to March 2015.

8. Agenda-3: Sector wise agenda

8.1 Gol special projects

(a) Financial Progress of the projects: Project wise financial progress up to March, 2014 both for GOI projects for the year of 2013-14 were put up before SLSC for its consideration and approval. After discussion on the various GOI projects, it was unanimously decided to surrender the savings of the GOI scheme i.e. Initiative for nutritional security through intensive millets promotion (INSIMIP), Rainfed Area Development Programme (RADP), Accelerated Fodder Development Programme (AFDP), IDPVR and Special programme on Oil Palm

Area Expansion (OPAE) which has either been merged with other scheme or closed.

It was unanimously decided to keep Vegetable Initiative for urban cluster (VIUC), NMPS-Goatery and NMPS-fisheries Ongoing for the year 2014-15. Chief Secretary suggested to take necessary steps to assure the quality of seeds distributed under VIUC projects of Horticulture. Also, the Chairman instructed Commissioner of Fisheries to make the expenditure under NMPS fisheries projects before March 2015.

8.2 Stream-1

- (a) Modification in the projects: Total 4 projects were put up for modification/change in total project outlay or component change. All the proposed modifications in projects were approved by the Committee unanimously after detailed discussion. The Details are attached as per Annexure-1.
- (b) Post Facto approval: Joint secretary (RKVY) suggested to submit Post Facto approval cases in State Level Screening Committee and there after submit such cases for approval of SLSC.
- (c) Financial progress of the projects of 2013-14: Project wise financial progress up to March, 2014 both for continuous and new projects under steam-I for the year of 2013-14 was put up before SLSC for its consideration and after detailed discussions, the same was approved by the committee.
- (c) Financial progress up to November-2014 of the projects of 2014-15: Project wise financial progress up to November, 2014 both for continuous and new projects for the year of 2014-15

was put up before SLSC for its consideration. SLSC advised the implementing agencies to expedite completion/expenditure in their projects expeditiously.

- (d) Grant requirement for 2014-15 (Continuous projects): Grant requirement of 15 continuous projects worth Rs. 3488.60 lakhs for 2014-15 were approved except for the project of "Project SagarLakshmi". The Details are attached as per Annexure-2
- (e) Dropped Project in 2014-15: After detailed discussions and explanation given by respective implementing agency, the Committee decided to drop 18 projects in 2014-15. Details are attached as per Annexure-3
- (f) New projects for 2014-15: 9 projects of 5 different implementing agencies after due scrutiny by the Screening committees headed by Principal Secretary (Agri.) were proposed for consideration of SLSC. Written comments of G.O.I. in request of each project were brought to the notice of the SLSC. After detailed discussions, 9 projects were approved after detailed discussion with an outlay of Rs. 41414.90 lakhs for 2014-15.

Detailed remarks on each project are as per Annexure -4.

8.3 Stream-II

Financial Progress: The expenditure of Rs. 606.87 of the project "ISOPOM-OPP" implemented by Gujarat State Seed Corporation of was approved as Stream-II project.

9. ATMA SEWP 2014-15

The State Extension Work Plan of ATMA for year 2014-15 was put up for approval before committee by State Nodal Officer, ATMA & Director, SAMETI. The same was approved by the committee after discussion.
