Minutes of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting on RKVY for 2014-15 held on 14-07-2014 at Chief Secretary's Conference Hall at 11.30 AM, Kohima, Nagaland.

Meeting Agenda:-

- 1. Review of ongoing RKVY programme 2013-14.
- 2. Approval of Project/Schemes of RKVY 2014-15 for Agri & Allied Departments.
- 3. Any other with permission from the Chair.

Minutes;

- 1. The meeting was held under the Chairpersonship of Chief Secretary, Nagaland, Smt. Banuo. Z Jamir, IAS.
- 2. The meeting was attended by Shri. Toshi Aier, IAS, ACS & Financial Commissioner, Nagaland Shri. R.B Thong IAS, Development Commissioner, Nagaland, all Administrative Heads and Heads of Department of Agri & Allieds.
- 3. Shri. R.K Singh, Joint Secretary (Agriculture) Ministry of Agriculture, New Delhi represented Government of India.

1st Agenda minutes:

- 1. The Chairperson and Chief Secretary warmly welcome the members with a note that this is the first State level meeting in connection with RKVY during the year and stated about the purpose of meeting. Thereafter, she requested the APC to initiate the meeting.
- 2. Shri. T. Imkonglemba Ao, IAS, APC & Commissioner & Secy Agriculture, gave in detail the power point presentation covering ongoing RKVY projects of 2013-14 by 9(nine) Agri & Allied departments in 11 Districts and 11 Blocks involving 21 Villages in the State. He also presented the State Agriculture Food-grain production achievement made so far during the last 3(three) years from 2011-12 to 2013-14 and projection for the year 2014-15. Further, the presentation covered the Basic monitorable indicators that determines the Growth rate and development of the State with other mission mode programme performance in the State and stated that the major contribution towards this achievement was due to RKVY funding from Govt. of India.
- 3. The presentation also stated the status of Fund release during 2013-14 which was neither as per SLSC approved nor GOI approved amount and the short release was to the tune of Rs.21.83 Crore as per GOI approved amount. Therefore, GOI was requested for consideration of more RKVY fund during the current year 2014-15, so as to cover up the committed expenditure of the previous year.

2nd Agenda

- 4. The Action Plan for 2014-15 under RKVY was laid before the house for deliberation and approval of SLSC by APC & CS (Agri). He further stated that the same action plan had already been scrutinized by the State level Technical Screening Committee on 23-06-14.
- 5. Shri. R.K Singh, Joint Secretary (Agriculture) Ministry of Agriculture GOI gave the following observations on the action plan basing on the observations given by the respective Divisions in the Ministry.
 - seed rates quoted in the action plan were not as per cost norms of NFSM. In reply, the Director of Agriculture justified by stating that the State does neither have seed production agencies nor have seed certifying agencies and only dependence is NSC or SFCI for procurement of certified seeds and for which the Seed rates quoted were strictly as per NSC/SFCI in case of certified seeds and State Govt. approved rates in case of Local Seeds/TLS seeds procurement. For which the GOI was requested for consideration.
 - b. Transportation & Monitoring/Evaluation in all the components of scheme to be avoided. In reply, the Chief Secretary stated that all cost norms & guidelines of CSS be adhered to and suggested the departments to make necessary corrections in their action plan before final submission.
 - c. Promotion of NPK & SSP under INM need to be corrected as it is not permissible.
 - d. Under Marketing Post Harvest Management (Value addition) the details of equipments/Machineries were not mentioned-which need to be added in detail along with cost norms.
 - e. Power Tiller Path being road construction was objected, In reply, the Director of Agriculture justified by stating that this power Tiller Path is not a road construction but a path for power tiller movement from field to field which aims to promote agricultural mechanization in the State taking hill terrain and TRC system into consideration. This being one of the most successful schemes ongoing in the State, GOI was requested for consideration. In this connection, the Chief Secretary supported by stating that this scheme was considered in the last SLSC and the programme has already been started successfully, GOI may have to consider even for this year.
 - f. Farm development need detail fund breakup and renovation or maintenance should not be taken up under RKVY. In reply, the department has accepted for necessary action.
 - g. Agri Expo proposal need to have detail fund break up. In reply, the APC stated that the necessary correction will be done as advised.
 - h. In Sericulture sector, the Textile components should be removed being separate Ministry.
 - i. All other components where cost norms were not followed as per CSS norms need to be corrected accordingly.
 - j. The Chief Secretary accordingly suggested for strict adherence to cost norms where ever necessary.
