

Minutes of RKVY State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) Meeting-held on 28 January, 2015 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary Uttarakhand

Presence-

Principal Secretary Agriculture Govt. of Uttarakhand extended a warm welcome to the Chairperson, Joint Secretary, Department of Agriculture & Co-operation GOI, Secretaries of different departments and other members of the Committee and their representatives. Principal Secretary Agriculture mentioned that Govt. of India has allocated Rs 9539.00 lakh for the year 2014-15, against which Rs. 4570.00 lakh has been released. Principal Secretary also mentioned that the projects costing to Rs. 10800 lakhs also require funding for the year 2014-15 which were already approved in the last SLSCs held on 04.08.2013, 04.12.2013 & 26.08.2014 including the special schemes under NMPS costing to Rs. 1123 lakh iz (By-pass protein supplement feed manufacturing plant at Kalsi for Rs. 532.11 lakh & Establishment of automatic compact fodder block manufacturing units at Shaympur Rishikesh and Rudrapur, U.S.Nagar) Principal Secretary Agriculture requested the honorable members of the Committee to discuss on the Agenda points.

Agenda 1- Confirmation of the proceeding of last SLSC meeting held on 26.08.2014

The minutes of the last SLSC meeting held on 26.08.2014 were confirmed as circulated.

Agenda 2- Review of Financial Progress of RKVY

The Status of the releases, expenditure and UCs submitted to Govt. of India since inception, discussed before the Committee as circulated. Principal Secretary Agriculture stated that Rs 33809.02 lakhs has been released by the GOI against which Rs. 31987.77 lakhs has been utilized till December, 2014 which is 95%. The UCs amounting to Rs 31987.77 lakhs has already been submitted to GOI till December, 2014 for the year 2014-15. An Amount of Rs. 4570 lakh has been released as 1st installment against Rs. 2827.24 lakh has been utilized till December, 2014, which is 62% and as per GOI norms state is eligible for 2nd installment for which proposal has already been submitted to Ministry of Agriculture duly supported by the UCs and Physical & Financial reports updated on RDMIS.

Chairperson directed all concerned departments to utilize unspent balances and submit UCs there of timely.

Agenda 3- List of New Projects for Approval

The Principal Secretary Agriculture mentioned that the state Screening Committee has scrutinized and recommended new projects worth of Rs 27540.81 lakhs against allocation for 2014-15. A presentation on the summary of each of the proposed new projects of the different department was presented before the Committee. After discussion the committee approved the projects as under:-

Joint Secretary GOI pointed out that, there are no specific cost norms for it. Director Sericulture apprised that the project has been prepared as per GOI Vanya Silk cost norms.

The committee after discussion approve the proposed project as presented.

(4) Animal Husbandry Department

Joint Secretary, Govt. of India pointed out that as per the comments of the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairy and fisheries. The proposed project micro dairy is although supported, subject to availability of cross breed cow/ buffalo with 25% subsidy of the project cost to Gen Category and 33.33% to SC/ST Beneficiaries. It is also suggested that the proposal for induction of at least two instead of one milch animal may be appropriate and may be taken up in phased manner instead of covering all 13 District in single stretch. Chairperson directed that State department of Animal Husbandry should revise the project as per RKVY Guidelines and GOI suggestion strictly.

(10) Uttarakhand Tarai Seed Development Corporation (TDC)

Joint Secretary, Govt. of India pointed that Ministry of Agriculture has not supported for incentive to farmer for production of certified seeds of cereals crops, only incentive to the farmers will be given for producing certified seed of pulses and oil seed. The Chairperson told that TDC mainly produces certified seed of wheat, which is supplied to many States so incentive also given to cereal crop. Joint Secretary GOI said that he will discuss the matter with seed division of Ministry of Agriculture GoI again.

The committee principally approved the project with the condition the project should be again sent for comment to the seed division of GOI before funding the project.
