As you are aware, the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), with an envisaged outlay of Rs. 25,000 crore during the 11th Five Year Plan, has been implemented during 2007-08.

- 2. The allocation of funds to the States/UTs under RKVY based on the approved outlay of Rs. 1,500 crore during 2007-08 was made and funds to the tune of 25% of the allocation were released to the States under Stream-II of the scheme during November, 2007. Many States have already held the meetings of the State Level Stream-I of RKVY. Upto 90% of the Stream-I funds (combining the first and the second instalments) are being released to the States to expedite the implementation of the projects.
- 3. RKVY, being the flagship scheme of the Department of Agriculture & Cooperation, would be monitored intensively. The formats devised for monitoring the progress of implementation of RKVY comprising 5 statements are enclosed. It is from the Nodal Agency/Department so as to reach us not later than the 10th of the subsequent month beginning from January, 2008.
