**Subject: Inter-state allocation under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana-  
Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied sector  
Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR) for the year 2018-19 - regarding.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey approval of the competent authority for State/Union Territories (UT) wise allocation of funds (Central share) under Normal RKVY-RAFTAAR, Special Component Plan for Scheduled Caste (SCSP) and Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) for 2018-19 as per the Statement annexed.


Like last year, funds under RKVY-RAFTAAR during 2018-19 have been provided separately for NER states and other States with a further trifurcation among General, SCSP and TSP components. The allocation under Normal RKVY-RAFTAAR (General component) has been calculated as per the criteria envisaged in Appendix B of RKVY-RAFTAAR Guidelines. The funds earmarked under SCSP and TSP components have been allocated to the States on the basis of population of SC/ST in the respective States. For UTs, funds have been allocated on the basis of ratio of Net sown area of the UTs to their Geographical Area.

Accordingly, the inter-state allocations (Central share) of Normal RKVY-RAFTAAR under General, SCSP and TSP components have been approved by the competent authority as per column 3, 4 and 5 of the Statement annexed. Funds will be released to the States under these 3 components of different budget heads separately for which separate Utilization Certificates will be required to be submitted by the States to this Department.

It is reiterated that the changed funding pattern of RKVY-RAFTAAR from 100:0 to 60:40 between Centre and States (90:10 for the North Eastern and 3 Himalayan States) since 2015-16 shall also be applicable the current FY i.e 2018-19. States need to contribute State share accordingly. However, for UTs, the grant is 100% under RKVY-RAFTAAR.
