Sir.

During 2016-17, "Bringing Green Revolution to Eastern India (BGREI)" -a sub scheme of RKVY would be implemented with 60:40 sharing pattern between Centre and State for general category States and 90:10 for Assam. States are requested to provide required State share in their budget of 2016-17. State-wise allocation including State share during the year 2016-17 are as under:

Out of total outlays made to State, 1% funds may be earmarked for contingency expenditure for effective monitoring of the programme as in normal RKVY. Thus, after deducting this contingency fund, State has to ensure that out of the total balance outlay (i.e. 99%); at least 80% of fund is allocated for rice and up to 20% for wheat for each of the component mentioned above. However, in case State does not allocate any fund for wheat, entire outlay shall have to be allocated for rice only

The cropping system based approach which has been included under BGREI entails that demonstrations are done in cropping sequence on the same plot of land. State should conduct at least 30% demonstrations under cropping system based approach.

While preparing the Action Plan, the following points may be kept in view:

- BGREI will be implemented only those non-NFSM districts which were covered under the programme during last year.
- Under BGREI program, wheat component will be implemented in districts not covered under NFSM-wheat.
- In the districts where BGREI programme will be implemented, the interventions covered under BGREI guidelines will only be applicable.
- Similarly, in the districts where NFSM programme is to be implemented, the interventions covered under NFSM guidelines will only be Applicable.
- Out of the funds proposed for block/cluster demos, 30% funds have to be earmarked for cropping system based demonstrations. States may also ensure that 30% demonstrations are organized on stress tolerance rice varieties.
- Similarly, State should ensure that out of the funds earmarked for seed distribution, 30% fund goes for promotion of stress tolerant varieties of rice.
- It may be ensured that the physical targets proposed by State are realistic, based on area in identified districts for a particular crop taking into consideration the past performance and duly approved by SLSC.

- While proposing the activities under Site Specific and Post harvest & Marketing Support, it may be ensured that the proposal is duly supported by unit, cost/rate, pattern of assistance, etc.
- While submitting the Action Plans to this Ministry, State should ensure that the proposed action plan is supported with the information indicated in the Templates at Annexure-I.

State Governments are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangements to prepare their action plan for the year 2016-17 in the format given at Annexure-II & Annexure-III, for Rice & Wheat, respectively (as the case may be) of the revised guidelines already circulated to State last year, in consultation with SAU/CRRI, Cuttack and other stakeholders and get the same discussed and approved by the State Steering Committee (SSC) at the earliest and furnish the hard & soft copies of the same to this Ministry latest by 1st week of May, 2016 so that necessary approval could be accorded.
