

**MINUTES OF THE ELEVENTH MEETING OF THE STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (SLSC) OF RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA (RKVY) HELD ON 18.06.2015 AT 04.00 PM IN COMMITTEE ROOM NO. 1 OF SECRETARIAT, JAIPUR**

The meeting was presided over by the Additional Chief Secretary (Agriculture), Rajasthan. The list of participants is enclosed at **Annexure I**.

The agenda items were discussed and the following decisions were taken:-

**1. Agenda Item No. 1: Confirmation of minutes of last meeting held on 10-07-2014 (10<sup>th</sup> meeting):**

The minutes of the 10<sup>th</sup> SLSC meeting held on 10.07.2014 were confirmed.

**2. Agenda Item No.2: Financial progress under RKVY during 2014-15:** The Department-wise and scheme wise expenditure of ₹ 71749.15 Lacs incurred during the year 2014-15 against the available funds of ₹ 76730.50 Lacs was placed before the Committee. GOI has revalidated the unspent balance of ₹ 4352.00 lacs against ₹ 4981.00 lacs. The remaining unspent balance of ₹ 629.00 lacs is under process at GOI level. The committee noted the same.

**3. Agenda Item No. 3 : Ex-post facto approval for project proposals implemented during 2014-15 with the approval of the Chairman, SLSC on file:** Ex-post facto approval was granted to the projects of ₹ 2376.63 Lacs. The details of the approved projects are at **Annexure II**.

**4. Before discussion on Agenda Item 4, Additional Commissioner( Extn.), Ministry Of Agriculture, DAC GOI , Sh. Virendra Singh mentioned following salient features of the new Operational guidelines of RKVY and general comments from GOI:**

1. The State, while releasing the funds to Implementing Agency, will ensure that the projects fulfil all the conditions prescribed in the new Operational Guidelines of RKVY 2014, e.g.
  - (i) Cost Norms: Cost Norms of Govt. of India/State Govt. Schemes/Programmes shall be followed. In case, no cost norms is available , SLSC can take a conscious decision on the proposed cost norms based on local parameters. (para 4.6 of RKVY Guidelines, 2014).
  - (ii) Pattern of Assistance, specified in various central Government Schemes will be applicable to the Projects. Where no pattern of assistance is available, assistance under RKVY should not be more than 25% of the Project Cost.

- (iii) All Government (Centre/State) and quasi – Govt. (Fully funded organization, State Agriculture Universities, Panchayati Raj Institutions, Primary Agriculture Credit Societies (PACS) etc. may be entitled to 100% funding of project cost under RKVY for creation of assets/ infrastructure to promote activities in agriculture and allied sectors. Technical Requirements/Standards specified in various Central Government Schemes will be applicable to these Projects.
2. While implementing approved projects, State may ensure that there should not be any duplication of funds with the activities of any other scheme.
  3. In no case, fund can be released to a project which is in the Negative List prescribed in appendix B of RKVY Guidelines.
  4. All recurring expenditure will be subject to Negative list, (Annexure D) & 1% administrative cost Guidelines.
  5. State Government may ensure that there is no overlapping of assistance for a project under RKVY from other schemes.


#### 4. Agenda item no. 4 : Letters from Govt. of India.

DAC, MOA, GOI has issued various letters regarding changed funding pattern, interim allocation to State, Revalidation of Unspent balance as on 1-4-2015, revised guideline of RKVY were noted by SLSC.

#### 5. Agenda item no. 5 : Requirement of funds for Pending Liabilities of 2014-15 & Ongoing projects during 2015-16.

Agenda was discussed in detail and following decisions were taken:

- i) The SLSC approved the funds for projects where pending liabilities of ₹ 4923.68 Lacs have been incurred before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015, GOI has allowed State/Implementing agencies to spend last year's unspent balance during 2015-16 on activities which were approved in last year's Action Plan as per funding pattern of last year (100% Centre Share) vide letter no. 7-3/2015-RKVY dated 12.06.2015, The project wise details are enclosed as **Annexure-III A**. Ex Post facto approval for allotment of funds towards remaining payments of Rs. 147.26 lacs on the event of launching of **SOIL HEALTH CARD SCHEME** and distribution of **KRISHI KARMAN AWARD** held on 19.02.2015 at Suratgarh, Sri-ganganagar by Hon'ble Prime Minister from the sanctioned project "Strengthening of knowledge resource by communication" was also granted.

  
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ii) Other on-going projects of ₹ 69586.91 Lacs were also approved for the year 2015-16 as per the guidelines of RKVY. The project wise details are at **Annexure-III B**.

**6. Agenda item No. 6 – Proposal for Administrative cost under RKVY for 2015-16:**

Proposal for Administrative cost ₹ 537.00 lacs under RKVY were approved as per details at **Annexure IV**.

**7. Agenda item No 7- New Project Proposals for 2015-16:** New Projects proposals were discussed and approved of ₹ 9765.76 Lacs for the year 2015-16 as per details at **Annexure-V**.

**8. Table Agenda:**

- i. With the permission of the Chair , 7 new projects were submitted by different departments i.e Water Resource, Cooperative and WD&SC Department after the agenda note was circulated for consideration of SLSC for approval. These projects were discussed by the SLSC. The details of the table agenda items are available at **Annexure VI**. The SLSC approved of ₹ 3103.00 Lacs for the year 2015-16 for the projects in table agenda as per guidelines of RKVY in addition to new project proposals.
- ii. ATMA- SEWP 2015-16 was also submitted to SLSC for approval as per GOI direction. ATMA SEWP plan for 2015-16 ₹ 7496.64 Lacs was approved by SLSC as per ATMA guidelines and norms. The details are given at **Annexure-VII**.


The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
