PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (SLSC) OF RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA (RKVY) HELD ON 01-07-2016 AT 3:30 P.M. UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SHRI DEPINDER SINGH DHESI, IAS, CHIEF SECRETARY, HARYANA IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, HARYANA CIVIL SECRETARIAT, CHANDIGARH.

The following decisions were taken on various agenda items:-

# Agenda No.1: Confirmation of the proceedings of last meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) held on 16.07.2015.

The proceedings of the last meeting of SLSC held on 16.07.2015 were confirmed.

#### Agenda No.2:

#### 2.1 Review of utilization of funds during 2014-15.

The Director Agriculture informed that out of the total released amount of Rs. 25468.00 Lakhs, an amount of Rs. 24368.21 Lakhs had been utilized during the year 2014-15 and an amount of Rs. 1094.10089 Lakhs remained unutilized which was required to be revalidated by the SLSC. CCS HAU, Hisar did not utilize an amount of Rs. 735.47 Lakhs with regard to which Dr. S.S. Siwach, Director Research, CCS HAU, Hisar assured for utilization of the said amount immediately. Likewise an amount of Rs. 256.50 Lakhs could not be utilized by HDDCFL due to release of 2<sup>nd</sup> Installment on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. Director General, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Development stated that Rs. 27.87264 lakhs have been utilized, but the bills could not be drawn in the month of March from the Treasury.

The SLSC gave its approval for revalidation of the said funds and it was desired that the funds must be utilized now without further delay.

## 2.2 Review of funds utilized during 2015-16.

The Director Agriculture informed that out of the total released amount of Rs. 23590.00 Lakhs, an amount of Rs. 13514.8320 Lakhs had been utilized during the year 2015-16 and an amount of Rs. 10075.1680 Lakhs remained unutilized which was required to be revalidated by the SLSC. ACS, Finance pointed out that

a major part of funds released under Crop Diversification in Original Green Revolution States remained unutilized. The Director Agriculture informed that due to late receipt of the 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment in the last week of March, 2016, the amount could not be drawn although the actual expenditure has been incurred to a large extent.

The SLSC approved revalidation and immediate utilization of these funds.

#### Agenda No.3: Department wise progress made during the year 2015-16.

The Director Agriculture informed about the progress of utilization of funds released to various implementing departments during the year 2015-16. It was apprised that the 1st instalment has been utilized, but 2nd instalment was received on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 and the bills were not accepted by the Treasury. The projects which involved higher monetary outgo were discussed in detail. Among the projects under Production Growth, the project of "Certified Seed Treatment" submitted by Agriculture Department could not be utilized as the Wheat Certified seed was not decided to be treated and the balance of Rs. 413.00 Lakhs is proposed to be utilized on account of outstanding payment of the private seed producers. An amount of Rs.103.20 Lakhs under the project "Distribution of Quality Pesticide / Fungicides on 50% subsidy" remained un-utilized due to late receipt of bills at the end of March. The Green Fodder Development Programme comprises crops of Oat and Sorghum which are sown in the month of March and that is why the amount of Rs. 465.4363 Lakhs remained unutilized. The project of providing subsidy on "Distribution of Certified Seeds of Paddy, Bajra, Wheat and Barley" involves previous year's liability and the balance amount of Rs. 1942.5934 Lakhs would be utilized in the current financial year.

Director General of Animal Husbandry & Dairying Department informed about balance amount of Rs. 733.8414 Lakhs under "Out-sourcing of A.I. services to J.K. Trust" that it is an ongoing programme for which the amount had already been spent and the payment would be made immediately on release of the amount.

On the project of "Detection, diagnosis and documentation of plant diseases and microorganisms" Director of Research, CCS HAU, Hisar informed that the cost of the microscope was Rs. 169.00 Lakhs and the balance amount of Rs. 117.3850 Lakhs was not sufficient to meet out the cost of the instrument.

Under Infrastructure & Assets, the project for "On-Farm Water Management" of the Agriculture Department, the Director Agriculture informed that about 90% amount has already been utilized and the remaining would also be utilized soon.

Director General of Horticulture Department informed about balance amount of Rs. 66.9835 Lakhs under "*Post Harvest Management*" that it is due to release of 2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2016.

On the project of "Establishment of Indo-Israel Centre of Excellence at Hisar", it was informed that the 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment was released on 31<sup>st</sup> March and the amount would be utilized in the current financial year. On the project of "Conservation and Genetic Improvement of Indigenous Breed", Director of Research, LUVAS, Hisar informed that release was made on 30<sup>th</sup> March and the amount would be utilized in the current financial year.

On the project of "*Up-gradation of Seed Processing Machineries*" Managing Director of HSDC informed that release was made on 30<sup>th</sup> March and the amount would be utilized in the current financial year.

On the project of "*Promotion for the cultivation of Prawn*", Director of Fisheries Department informed that the amount would be spent on getting the release of 2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment after revalidation.

During the course of discussion, it was suggested by ACS Cooperation, Haryana that cooperative projects may also be included under RKVY scheme. ACS, Finance told that area under commercial crops like sunflower had gone down over a period of time; therefore reasons behind the downward trend may be identified.

### **Agenda No.4: Regularization of Projects**

Surrendering of Budget by Haryana State Seed Certification Agency (HSSCA).

Under the project namely "For implementation of Organic Certification of Agricultural Crops and Products in Haryana" being implemented by HSSCA, it was informed by Sh. P.S. Chauhan (Dy. Director, HSSCA) that Rs. 30.00 Lakhs could not be utilized as accreditation by APEDA was required and in the absence of the accreditation, this amount has been surrendered. Similarly, an amount of Rs.26.00 Lakhs for the project namely "Establishment of Seed Testing lab at

*Rohtak*" was also surrendered by HSSCA during 2015-16. The SLSC accorded ex-post facto approval of the above.

## Agenda No.5: Sanctioning of the Projects for the year 2016-17.

Director Agriculture presented the new project proposals for the year 2016-17 before SLSC. The projects were discussed in detail one by one, Chairman also desired to have in depth discussion with regard to the projects costing above Rs.2.00 crores with the Administrative Secretaries. An extended meeting was held on 28.07.2016 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana for consideration of such project proposals and the proposals were deliberated in detail.
