	Principal Secretary (Agriculture) apprised that GoI had approved AFDP conditionally which is to be implemented if government declares drought situation, as State has not declared drought situation anywhere in the State, allocation under this scheme cannot be accessed. In case of RPS, he explained that a Pilot project will be taken in saline track of Purna river basin in Vidharbha region and Project Director, Nanaji Deshmukh Krishi Sanjeevani (PoCRA), is submitting the action plan for approval of GoI, and CDP is not being implemented in the State as area under tobacco is very small.  He further apprised that in FY 2016-17 ₹ 333.73 Cr. funds (GoI - ₹ 200.24 Cr. & State - ₹ 133.49 Cr.) have been released in first installment and so far, about 60% funds have been utilized. Thus, State government will be eligible to fetch the remaining ₹ 192.92 Cr. grants of Normal RKVY in second installment in February, 2017. The status of project wise / implementing agencies wise funds utilization of the fund received in FY 2016-17 is enclosed as annexure – III (a) & (b).

Chairman opined that if focus of the programme is to provide diesel / input subsidy and to carry out minor repair works, then expenditure on such activities shall be done through a regular scheme or under Jalyukt Shivar Yojana. He directed Principal Secretary (Agriculture) and Secretary (Water Conservation) that onwards assistance to Mahatma Jal-Bhumi Abhiyan shall not be provided under RKVY, as RKVY is a project based scheme. He further directed that remaining allocation of ₹ 35 Cr. shall not be made available and it should be de-sanctioned. Moreover, he directed to review the programme and if some of the grant released is likely to remain unspent by 31 <sup>st</sup> March, 2017, then those grants shall be surrendered to RKVY Cell before 15 <sup>th</sup> February, 2017. 	Out of 29 projects recommended by the SLPSC, the SLSC approved 17 projects, in which full or partial expenditure is possible up to March, 2017.
