### MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL STATE LEVEL SANCTION COMMITTEE MEETING OF RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA HELD ON 31-12-2016 AT 3:30 PM IN THE MINI MEETING HALL, 'C' BLOCK, TELANGANA SECRETARIAT, HYDERABAD.

The Special State Level Sanction Committee Meeting of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) scheme of Telangana State was held under the Chairmanship of the Sri. K. Pradeep Chandra, IAS., Chief Secretary/ Chairman SLSC (RKVY) Government of Telangana, on 31-12-2016 in the Mini Meeting Hall, 'C' block, Telangana Secretariat, to approve the project of Agriculture Marketing departments for implementation during 2016-17.

The Government of India was represented by Smt. I. Rani Kumidini IAS, Joint Secretary (INM/DM), DAC&FW, Govt. of India, Members of SLSC and HOD from Agriculture Marketing department were also present. The list of officers who attended the meeting is shown in *Annexure I*.

At the outset Sri. K. Pradeep Chandra, IAS., Chief Secretary/ Chairman SLSC (RKVY) welcomed the Govt. of India representatives and other participants to the meeting.

Shri C. Parthasarathi I.A.S., APC & Secretary (Agril. & Coop) has explained in brief about the budget status of RKVY scheme received during the year 2016-17. Further, he has stated that, the Govt. of India has indicated the final allocation of Rs. 713.80 Crores (Central Share of Rs.427.85 Cr and State Share of Rs. 285.23 Crores). As such, there is an additional allocation of Rs.442.45 Crores to the Government of Telangana.

Further the APC & Secretary, Agriculture has stated that, the additional allocation of Rs. 442.45 Crores has been allocated to the Agriculture Marketing Department in the Ratio of Rs. 265.45 Cr under Central share (60%) and Rs. 177.00 Crores under State Share (40%) by the than Chief Secretary/ Chairman SLSC, RKVY Dr. Rajeev Sharma, IAS.

#### Approval of the project proposals for the year 2016-17:

Sri. C. Parthasarathi, IAS, APC & Secretary, Agriculture, has stated that, the Agriculture Marketing Department has submitted the Detailed Project Report for construction of Scientific Godowns with a capacity of 7.37 LMTs amounting to Rs. 442.50 Crores under Infrastructure & Assets Scheme for approval under the SLSC meeting.

The details of the Construction of godowns being taken up by the Agriculture Marketing Department district wise are indicated below as per the suggestions made by the committee:

Smt. I. Rani Kumidini IAS, Joint Secretary (INM/DM), has stated that, the DAC & FW while offering the remarks on the project has recommended the eligibility for construction of Godown by the Agriculture Marketing Committee limiting to 25% as per the assistance provided under AMI sub-scheme of ISAM.

The APC & Secretary, Agriculture has clarified to the comments made by the DAC and stated that, the Govt. of India in their Explanatory Memorandum No.9-1/2013 Dt. 17-11-2014 has revised the operational Guidelines at Para No.4.3 and 4.6 which stipulates the capping of subsidy to 25% of the total project cost. The Govt. of India has further clarified that, the concept of beneficiary contribution would only arise in case of non state actors and all the Government (Centre/State) and Quasi Government agencies are entitled for 100% funding of the project cost under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana.

As such, the APC & Secretary, Agriculture has requested the committee for taking into the consideration the above clarification and approve the projects for the total cost of Rs.442.45 Crores.

Further, Smt. Laxmi Bai, Director, Marketing has stated that, as pointed out by the DAC, the estimates for construction of Godowns are in accordance with the norms of NABARD (under WIF) which has approved the rates for construction of godowns @ of Rs.6000/- per MT i.e. Rs.5000/- for construction and Rs.1000/- for ancillary items such as roads and electrification. As such, the project cost has been arrived at amounting to Rs.442.50 Crores for creating the storage space of 7.37 LMTs @ Rs.6000/- per MT and the Addl. Director Marketing has requested the Committee for consideration of the rates as approved by NABARD and approve the project.

Smt. I. Rani Kumidini, IAS, Joint Secretary (INM/DM), DAC, Govt. of India has agreed, for the proposals made by the APC & Secretary, Agriculture and requested the committee for approving the project as per the proposals of the APC & Secretary, Agriculture.

In principle the Committee and the Government of India representative has agreed to support the project with the financial assistance of Rs. 442.50 Crores in the ratio of Rs. 265.45 Cr under Central share (60%) and Rs. 177.00 Crores under State Share (40%).

The comments of the DAC along with the remarks and explanation are enclosed in *Annexure II*.

While concluding the meeting the APC & Secretary, Agriculture has thanked the Joint Secretary, Govt. of India and all other members and emphasized that the projects under RKVY must be implemented with due care.
