

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (SLSC) FOR THE RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA (RKVY) held UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE CHIEF SECRETARY, J&K ON 05.09.2017 AT 5.00 PM IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, 3RD FLOOR, CIVIL SECRETARIAT, SRINAGAR.

- At the outset Principal Secretary to Government, APD gave a brief introduction to the issues before the Committee while highlighting the broad objective of Doubling the Farmers' Income in the State. Thereafter, Mission Director, RKVY (Director Agriculture Kashmir) made a detailed presentation on the AAP 2017-18. **The observations conveyed by DAC&FW after the pre-SLSC meeting held on 16 August 2017 in DAC&FW were presented by the Mission Director and discussion took place. Considering the deliberations between Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Union Agriculture Minister at Srinagar on 4 July 2017, it was strongly felt that the RKVY Annual Action Plan 2017-18 already submitted to DAC&FW must be implemented without further delay, considering the limited working season across the agro-climatic zones of the State for meeting the broad objective of Doubling the Farmers' Income.**
- After due deliberation, SLSC decided as under:
 - 3.1. RKVY Annual Action Plan 2017-18 submitted to the DAC&FW by the Agriculture Production Department J&K with in principle approval of the Chief Secretary was confirmed and recommendations of SLPSC (RKVY) meeting held on 12 July 2017 were accepted. 3.1.2.Proposal of allocation of funds for on-going projects submitted by Agriculture and other line Department **RECOMMENDED** by SLPSC were accepted and approved.

3.1.3.For Agriculture Production Department, an allocation of Rs.2=00 cr (TWO CRORE) is recommended, over and above the ceiling under RKVY Normal for taking up training and skill development of stakeholders, production specific research projects, information dissemination, special projects etc considering the provisions of paragraph 8.5 of RKVY Guidelines.

3.1.4.Construction of Cold Store proposed to be taken up at a cost of Rs. 23.53 Lacs at Chenani at Jammu by Agro Industries Dev. Corporation will be handed over to Director Agriculture, Jammu as decided earlier in a meeting taken by Hon'ble Minister Agriculture at Srinagar in June 2017 The proposal of JK Agro for purchase of Cold Chain Refrigerated Van for maintaining value chain would be as per tendered amount of approx. Rs.37.30 lakh.

3.1.5.For Research and Development on Saffron in district Kishtwar, a provision of Rs. 30.00 Lacs was been allocated during the year 2017-18. It includes an allocation of Rs.5=00 lakh for preparation of DPR on Kishtwar Saffron Park through JK Agros / NHB.

3.1.8. The Action Plan 2017-18 under CSS-National Mission on Saffron Agriculture Department Kashmir, including allocation of Rs.30 lakh to SKUAST Jammu for Kishtwar Saffron was approved. It was directed that expenditure on branding, trademark registration, GI registration, brand promotion etc. should be made out of funds allocated under NSM subject to concurrence by DAC&FW.

3.1.9. It was recommended that considering the physical and financial progress so far the NSM time horizon should be extended by one more year that is up to 2018-19 in the best interests of the project

3.1.11. The Action Plan 2017-18 was also recommended to be implemented with full compliance of DBT / AADHAR guidelines and procurement on GeM (Govt e-Market) and e-tendering where applicable.

- 3.2. RKVY AAP must also geographically focus on coverage of 25 panchayats (50 villages) under convergence model by implementing integrated farming system (IFS) models developed by SKUAST K / J.
- 3.3. Concept of business villages be brought in.
- 3.4. Undertake outcome studies of the schemes to ensure that projects / schemes are implemented in accordance with the guidelines laid down.
- 3.5. Website of APD should highlight the achievements of RKVY and describe success stories and best practices.
- 3.6. Focus should be on meeting the financial and physical targets. Next SLSC meeting would be held on 5 October 2017.
- 3.7. Unspent balance of previous years should be allocated (excluding closed schemes) as per guidelines and action plan submitted to the Chief Secretary for approval.

The meeting ended with a Vote of thanks to the Chair.
