PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEVENTEENTH MEETING OF STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE ON RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKASA YOJANA, HELD ON 23/10/2017 AT ROOM NO.313, VIDHANA SOUDHA UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF THE CHIEF SECRETARY, GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

The meeting began with a welcome address by the Secretary, Agriculture Department to the Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka & Chairman, SLSC, RKVY, Joint Secretary, RKVY division, Department of Agriculture, Co-operation and Farmers Welfare, GOI and other participants of the meeting,. Initiating the discussions, Secretary(Agri) explained that the main objective of this SLSC was to review the status of implementation of 2017-18 projects and seek approval for RKVY sub-schemes. Other issues like ratification approvals, revalidation & re-allocation, utilisation of balance funds additional project proposals were also placed before the Committee for discussion and approval.

About the allocation to the State for the year 2017-18, which is Rs.397.71 crores (Central share - Rs.238.63 crores & State share - Rs.159.08 crores) under normal RKVY, the Chairperson expressed displeasure that though the Union Budget for RKVY had increased by 34% for the current year (in comparison with 2016-17), the increase in allocation to Karnataka is only 5.2%, despite better utilization of funds by the State. GOI was requested to re-consider enhancing the allocation as better performing States should be encouraged and supported with better funding.

The Joint Secretary, GOI, told the Committee, that the allocation was based on the parameters indicated in the RKVY guidelines. However, the request of the State shall be noted.

Further deliberations of the meeting are as follows:

1. Confirmation of the Proceedings of 16th meeting of SLSC, RKVY

Proceedings of the 16th meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee held on 15/05/2016 was confirmed.

Action taken report on 16th meeting of the SLSC:

a) Utilisation of unspent balance of 2016-17: GOI had released Rs.226.76 crores grants under Normal RKVY and Rs.15.55 crores for RKVY sub-schemes, total Central releases being Rs.242.31 crores. The State Govt. had also released the matching share of Rs.151.17 crores(Normal RKVY) and Rs.10.36 crores(RKVY sub-schemes). The total releases(Central & State share) for 2016-17 programme was Rs.403.84 crores. Out of this Rs.392.46 crores has been utilised and UC had been submitted to GOI on 25/05/2017 vide letter No.RKVY/U.C/2016-17. The unspent balance of Rs.11.38 crores was revalidated and released for utilisation during 2017-18. Out of this, an amount of Rs.10.28 crores has been utilised.

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Horticulture were instructed to expedite utilisation of the unspent balance and submit UC for the remaining amount by November end.

b) Third Party monitoring and evaluation:

The Departments/Institutions have taken up third party evaluation of projects like Micro Irrigation, Bhoo chethana etc., through Karnataka Evaluation Authority(KEA), other agencies like NABCONS, Agriculture Universities, Institute of Agriculture Technologists, NGOs etc., The Chairperson directed the nodal Department to co-ordinate with KEA and take up evaluation of RKVY projects.

2. SLSC approval and budget allocation

- **a)** In the 16th SLSC meeting on 15/05/2017, an action plan to the tune of Rs.497.13 crores under normal RKVY(Annexure-I) was approved wherein the GOI share is Rs.298.28 crores and GOK share is Rs.198.85 crores.
- **b)** GOI allocation under normal RKVY for 2017-18 is Rs.238.63 crores(60% Central share). The State matching share(40%) works out to Rs.159.08 crores. Therefore, as per GOI allocation, funds earmarked for 2017-18 is Rs.397.71 crores.

Secretary, Agriculture, explained that based on GOI allocation, for the total allocation of Rs.397.71 crores, as per RKVY guidelines, SLSC may approve projects upto 150% of the States allocations. Therefore, the SLSC can approve projects upto Rs.596.57 crores for the current year. Hence, an action plan of Rs.497.13 crores has been approved in the 16th SLSC.

The Chairperson suggested the Depts./Insts. to have separate list of projects like main list of projects for the budget approved according to GOI allocation, reserved list of projects for the difference of amount in SLSC approval & GOI allocation and additional list of projects for the balance available in State budget allocation.

Based on the GOI allocation and releases, Depts./Insts. may implement the main list of projects(Annexure-III). On availability of the balance funds as per 16th SLSC approvals, the projects under reserved list are to be implemented(Annexure-IV). If there are any additional releases by GOI matching the State budget allocation, the implementation of the projects in the additional list(Annexure-V) may be considered based on GOI/ICAR observations.

3. Implementation status 2017-18 RKVY programme:

GOI has released 1st installment grants of Rs.119.32 crores to which State has also released matching share of Rs.79.54 crores, the total releases being Rs.198.86 crores. The collective expenditure of Departments and Institutions is Rs.126.65 crores (63.68%). Details of progress is provided in Annexure-II.

Secretary, Agriculture, brought to the notice of the Committee the allocation under SCSP & TSP components which is as follows:

The Secretary, Agriculture, explained to the Committee that the implementing Depts./Insts. were finding it difficult to utilise the funds under SCSP & TSP components as majority of the approved projects come under Infrastructure & Assets stream(67.33%) and only 32.67% of the approved projects fall under Production Growth stream which includes beneficiary oriented projects. Therefore, considering the beneficiary oriented projects that are being implemented by the line Departments, wherein SCSP and TSP funds can be utilised, the Committee was requested to approve revision and reallocation from SCSP & TSP components to General component.

The Commissioner, Watershed Devp. Dept. expressed that during the year 2017-18 an amount of Rs.61.31 crore is approved for the construction of checkdams and the allocation was categorized and released. As the checkdams are being constructed in the common lands (Community Purpose), they cannot be categorized into Gen, SCP, TSP. Moreover construction of checkdam is a infrastructure oriented project and not a beneficiary oriented programme, it was requested to allot a deemed allocation of 5% under SCP and TSP grants.

The Committee deliberated in detail. The Joint Secretary, GOI expressed that the re-allocation of SCSP & TSP funds to other component is not possible in Central share. The Chairperson directed Secretary(Expenditure), Finance Dept. to revise the allocation under SCSP & TSP components in the State budget in accordance with the GOI allocation.

Further, to ensure complete utilisation of Central funds, the Depts. were instructed to submit project proposals for the allocation under SCSP & TSP components as indicated in the above table. A Sub- Committee meeting under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner including Secretary(Expenditure), Finance Dept., Secretary, Planning & Secretary Agri. to screen these proposals and submit for approval of the Chairman, RKVY SLSC.

For Watershed Devp. Dept. SCP/ TSP allocation shall be apportioned as per the category of the farmers who are benefitted by these checkdams.

5. Approval of RKVY Sub-Schemes for the year 2017-18

- a) Crop Diversification Programme for replacing tobacco farming with alternative crops /cropping system.
 - GOI has conveyed continuation of sub-scheme Crop Diversification Programme for the year 2017-18
 - An action plan has been approved by GOI for Rs.266.80 lakhs(Central share Rs.1.60 crores and State share Rs.1.07 crores) to take up alternate crop demonstrations of cereals, pulses, oil seeds and millets in Tobacco growing areas covering an area of 2534.8 ha in Mysore, Hassan and Belagavi Districts.
 - GOI vide letter F.No.1-8/2017-CU-II, dt:21/06/2017 has directed the State to take approval of RKVY SLSC for the above action plan.

The Committee accorded approval for an action plan of Rs.266.80 lakhs.

b) Reclamation of Problem (Alkali, Saline & Acid soils) Soils:

- For the year 2017-18, State Action Plan(SAP) treating an area of 1375 ha for an amount of Rs.833.33 lakhs (GOI share Rs.500.00 lakhs and GOK share Rs.333.33 lakhs) was approved in the 16th SLSC.
- However, GOI has approved an action plan of Rs.2.50 crores (Central share Rs.1.50 crores and State share Rs.1.00 crore).
- Further, GOI in its letter F.No.11-8/2016-NRM.1, dt:01/06/2017 has status that although AAP has approval of SLSC during 2016-17 but it may be included in AAP of 2017-18 and approved by SLSC as per RPS guidelines.

The Committee discussed and accorded approval for the revised action plan of Rs.2.50 crores.

c) Additional Fodder Development Programme(AFDP):

- The sub-scheme provides for distribution of fodder production kits to farmers for a maximum of 2ha/beneficiary in drought affected Districts
- The Department of Animal Husbandry had submitted to GOI an action plan of Rs.18.92 crores for distribution of 52800 fodder production kits.

- However, GOI in the letter F.No.1-12/2017-RKVY, dt:07/09/2017 has communicated that due to limited availability of funds, Central assistance(60%) of Rs.7.00 crores only has been approved for 2017-18. With the matching State share(40%) of Rs.4.66 crores, the total allocation works out to Rs.11.665 crores.
- In the above referred letter, GOI has directed the State to take approval of RKVY SLSC for the revised action plan of Rs.11.665 crores.

The Committee accorded approval for an action plan of Rs.11.665 crores subject to GOI allocation.

6.Revision of 2017-18 allocation to Sericulture Dept.

An allocation of Rs.17.98 crores was approved to Sericulture Dept. for implementing 9 projects. However, the Dept. has requested to reduce the allocation to Rs.12.88 crores for implementing 7 projects listed below as the Dept. is unable to take up two of the 16th SLSC approved projects due to technical reasons:

The Committee approved an allocation of Rs.12.88 crores to Sericulture Dept.

7. Revalidation of unspent balance

- The project "Soil Testing and Distribution of Soil Test Cards" was approved in the 11th SLSC 2014-15 at a project cost of Rs.5.00crores.
- An amount of Rs.28.81lakhs released to above mentioned project remained unutilized due to technical reasons and the money is available with the State.

The Committee approved the revalidation of the unspent balance.

8. Ratification of earlier approved projects:

a) Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services:

i) Additional Fodder Development Programme was sanctioned for Rs.16.80 crores during 2016-17. Out of this, an amount of Rs.14.57 crores was utilised for the distribution of Fodder mini kits to farmers. As the State was reeling under severe drought, an amount of Rs.222.75 lakhs was utilised for the Fodder Seed Production in Departmental Livestock Farms as per State Government norms, in 500 acres, which was further distributed to farmers as per the directions of the Chief Secretary GOK vide Note Sheet Para No.23 of File No.CAH/RKVY/CR-09/2017-18 (Part-3) dated:21-06-2017.

The Committee deliberated and approved utilisation of Rs.222.75 lakhs for Fodder seed production in Dept. livestock farms.

ii) The project "Creation of infrastructure for training facility for farmers and Veterinary Livestock Assistance training Centre at Belgavi" was approved in the 16th SLSC(page-12 of 16th SLSC proceedings). However, in the annexure of the 16th SLSC proceedings at page-53, it has been erroneously referred as "Creation of infrastructure for training of farmers in Piggery, Rabbit rearing at Hesaraghatta training Center at LBF, Hesaraghatta". This mis-reference was brought to the notice of the Committee. The Committee approved for the title of the project in page-53 of 16th SLSC proceedings to be recorded as "Creation of infrastructure for training facility for farmers and Veterinary Livestock Assistance training Centre at Belgavi"

9. Re-allocation of funds:

a) **Department of Agriculture:** An allocation of Rs.100.34 crores was approved for implementation of 9 projects in the 16th SLSC as follows:

The funds approved for the project K-KISAN(Rs.6.00 crore) is proposed for reallocation to two new projects - Integrated Farmers Call center(Rs.3.50 crores) and for taking up IT initiatives in Dept. of Agriculture - developing application modules for various GOI & GOK schemes(Rs.2.50 crores) details are as follows:

i) Integrated Farmers Call Centre(Rs.3.50 crores)

To enable efficient Transfer of Technology and extension system, the Department, as directed by the honorable Agriculture Minister and also emphasized by the Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner, intends to establish an Integrated Farmers Call Centre based on a dynamic database and regularly updated knowledge through experts in research and extension system. The Integrated Agriculture Call Centre shall be established, operated and maintained by a Service Provider. The Broad objectives of this call centre are as follows:

- To establish digital mode of functional Integrated Agriculture Call Centre.
- The initial response by call centre executives for farmer's queries in IVR system.
- Automatic call routing facility to the concerned sectors (Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Fisheries/ Animal Husbandry/ Sericulture/ Agriculture Marketing etc.,)

- Call escalation structure in three tier system.
- Automatically Call escalation of unresolved issues at different levels to the next level.
- Automatic tracking and monitoring of the queries at each level.
- Push back final resolved queries digitally to the callers (farmers).
- Dash board for information with respect to query resolution, pendency etc.,

The Dept. has availed the consultancy services of Technical Consultancy Services Organisation of Karnataka(TECSOK) for preparing the DPR. This consultancy charges shall be met out of the RKVY administrative cost.

ii) IT initiatives in Dept. of Agriculture - developing application modules for various GOI & GOK schemes(Rs.2.50 crores)

Department has taken steps to strengthen the extension system by greater use of modern Information and Communication Technology (ICT) application from RSK to Secretariat (Agriculture) to meet the core functions of the Department viz., service delivery, information dissemination, public grievances and redressal, schemes/programme implementation and to have interfaces with other Department.

In this regard, the Department, in association with NIC has developed and is using web enabled application modules for implementing the following schemes.

- Collection of farmers information so as to create farmer data base
- Presently, 30.00 lakh farmer data base has been compiled
- Distribution of farm implements, agro processing units, micro irrigation systems
- Implementation of Krishi Bhagya scheme
- Agriculture input supply systems to farmers for agri inputs seeds, micro nutriens, manures, plant protection chemicals etc.,

In line with GOI guidelines, the Department aims to develop application modules for implementation of Centrally Sponsored and State Sector Schemes incorporating Direct Benefit Transfer with the following objectives

- To prevent and address delays, reduce structural expenses in distributing the benefits and to encourage farmers to have bank linked transactions for financial activities.
- To bring in transparency in implementation of Centrally sponsored and state sector schemes.

In view of this, it is proposed to develop application modules for soil health integration, DBT, Finance, Purchase, Sales & Inventory modules for all products, Learning Management system, SMS gateway, MIS modules, Business intelligence, Document Management system etc., through Service Providers.

The Committee approved the reallocation of funds for the above mentioned projects and to bear the consultancy charges of Technical Consultancy Services Organisation of Karnataka(TECSOK) from RKVY administrative cost.

iii) Designing of Sorghum Harvester and fine-tuning of millet processing machine for better efficiency(IIMR)

- The State is promoting organic agriculture and minor millet cultivation on a large scale. To provide market linkages for these products, the Department had organized National Trade fair and has planned for an International Trade fair on organics & millets during January 2018. In this regard, the Dept. in partnership with Indian Institute of Millets Research(IIMR) is encouraging development of millet processing machines.
- It is proposed to support IIMR for R&D activities in developing millet processing machines. An amount of Rs.50.00 lakes will be provided for IIMR out of the project cost approved for Bhoo Chethana.

The Committee accorded approval for allocation of Rs.50.00 lakes to IIMR out of the approved project cost of Bhoo Chethana.

b) Department of Agriculture Marketing:

- In the 13th SLSC, the project "Providing Market Infrastructure facilities like Scientific storage Godowns, Covered auction platforms, cold storages sunday Markets, solid waste managements system in the selected APMC's" was approved for Rs.236.00 crores.
- An amount of Rs.123.22 crores was released during 2015-16 and Rs.54.62 crores was released during 2016-17 under RKVY. The APMCs contributed Rs.32.60 crores. A total amount of Rs.210.44 crores has been utilised for this project till date.
- In the 16th SLSC, an amount of Rs.25.00 crores was approved for completing the project during 2017-18.

- However, the Department has requested to re-allocate the above approved funds of Rs.25.00 crores, to a new project "Development of covered auction platforms and Sunday markets in 73 APMCs" on 50:50 fund sharing of RKVY: APMC funds. The total project cost is Rs.50.00 crores and the balance Rs.25.00 crores will be met out of APMC funds.
- The funds of Rs.25.00 crores as approved in the 16th SLSC to complete the 2015-16 ongoing project shall be met from the concerned APMC's.

The Committee discussed in detail and approved the re-allocation of Rs.25.00 crores provided the Department re-submits the DPR immediately, including the details of construction of Covered Auction Platforms in earlier RKVY projects, proposed Covered Auction Platforms with justification and details of commodity arrivals and turnover.

c) University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad:

- The SLSC had approved 5 Projects worth Rs.6.41 crores for the year 2017-18.
- As per the ICAR Comments, the project cost of "Molecular breeding and genetic enhancement in breaking yield barriers in Pulses", has been reduced to Rs.1.45crores from Rs.2.45crores.
- The University has proposed to implement a new project "Enhancing Water use Efficiency Using Micro Irrigation Systems in Major Crops in Malaprabha Left Bank Canal of Command Areas of Northern Karnataka" for the balance amount of Rs.1.00 crore from above project.

The Committee accorded approval for implementing the above project as per ICAR observations.

d) University of Agricultural Sciences, Raichur

- i) The project "Eco care Rice Production with Enhanced input efficiency in irrigated command areas" was sanctioned Rs.0.30 crores for implementation during 2016-17 in Tungabhadra project area
 - Due to non availability of water in TBP area, it is difficult to implement the project. The same work will be taken up in Upper Krishna project area during 2017-18.

The Committee approved the change of location to upper Krishna project area.

• The projects "Strengthening of Food Quality Testing Laboratory by Establishing Food Micro Biology" and "Determination of quality of pesticide formulate at Hyderabad Karnataka region" were sanctioned Rs.0.81 crores and Rs.0.90 crores respectively for procurement of laboratory equipments, consumables and recurring contingencies in the 16th SLSC. However, the University is seeking approval to utilise Rs.0.75 crore and Rs.0.60 crore respectively out of the funds approved for construction of laboratory in the above mentioned projects.

The Committee discussed and approved the utilisation of funds mentioned above for construction of laboratory

10. Utilisation of available balance funds

a) Karnataka State Natural Disaster Monitoring Cell(KSNDMC)

- During the year 2013-14 the project "Establishment of Rain gauges at 3031 Gram Panchayaths and Automatic Weather Stations" was approved and Rs.25.00 crores was released.
- Due to reduction in some of the items such as GPRs connectivity, web enabled services charges etc., an amount of Rs.367.89 lakhs remains unspent.
- The Cabinet sub-committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Honorable Revenue minister to examine the drought situation in the State took decision for establishment of Telemetric raingauge network in the newly formed 439 Gram Panchayaths.
- The estimated budget for the establishment Telemetric raingauges at 439 newly formed GPs and maintenance of these stations for 5 years will be Rs.350.53 lakhs.

The Committee approved utilisation of the balance funds of Rs.350.53 lakhs for establishing Telemetric raingauges in 439 new GPs

11. Proposal of Mahalanobis National Crop Forecast Centre for 16 most drought vulnerable districts in Karnataka

- Govt. of India has tentatively allocated a fund Rs.4.00 Crore under RKVY for the year 2017-18 vide letter No.F.No.2-1/2017-NRAA, Dt.15th Sept. 2017 to National Rainfed Area Authority (NRRA) to formulate a project proposal cum action plan for most vulnerable drought prone districts in the states of Andrapradesh, Karnataka and Rajasthan as per NMSA guidelines.
- Districts in which drought was declared more than 10 times during 2000-2015 in Karnataka are as follows:

- NRRA has been assigned the task of providing technical inputs in the area of water Management, Rainwater conservation, Watershed Development and Integrated Farming System(IFS) as well as extending advisory to States for implementation and monitoring to undertake demonstration on package of practices to address the issues of most vulnerable drought prone districts.
- ICAR- CRIDA, Hyderabad has been assigned the responsibility to facilitate the process of preparation of plans for the above 16 districts, including specific interventions of Center / States for drought proofing and convergence of various activities of line departments related to drought proofing programmes in close consultation with state/district level officers of Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal husbandry, Irrigation (surface and ground water resources), Rural development etc.
- A meeting was organized on 29th June 2017 under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner at Bengaluru involving Scientists from CRIDA to discuss about plan preparations.
- A second meeting with Scientists of CRIDA was held on 16th September 2017 at KSNDMC, Bengaluru to discuss the District Action Plans of the southern districts (Hassan, Kolar, Mandya, Mysuru, Chitradurga, Tumakuru, Bengaluru Rural and Davanagere district).

The Committee approved the above proposal in principle subject to implementation as per GOI directions and availability of funds

12. Additional proposals for the year 2017-18:

- The State Government has provided a budget of Rs.602.65 crores (Central share of Rs.361.59 crores: State share of Rs.241.06 crores) for implementation of RKVY 2017-18.
- Out of this, considering the action plan approved in 16th SLSC (Rs.497.13 crores), allocation for sub-schemes(Rs.16.84 crores), budget provision for revalidation amount(Rs.11.67 crores) amounting to Rs.525.64 crores, balance of Rs.77.01 crores is still available in the State budget.
- There are additional projects for this balance budget allocation(Annexure-V).
- However, Central share allocated by GOI is Rs.248.73 crores only. An additional Central share of Rs.112.86 crores needs to be provided by GOI as per the State budget allocation.

The Committee recommended GOI to consider providing additional Central share matching the State budget allocation.

13 Any other issues:

a) Reclamation of Problem (Alkali, Saline & Acid soils) Soils:

- During the year 2016-17 DAC & FW, GOI vide letter dated 21/11/2016 had approved State Action Plan (SAP) for reclamation of 825 ha of saline and alkaline soils at an estimated cost of Rs.500.00 lakhs(Central share Rs.300.00 lakhs(60%) + State share Rs.200.00 lakhs(40%)).
- GOI vide its letter Date:02/12/2016 released Central share of Rs.150.00 lakhs and State released its share of Rs.99.33 lakhs totaling Rs.249.33 lakhs as 1st installment grant. Though, Utilization Certificate for Rs.249.33 lakhs was submitted to GOI, 2nd installment grants was not released by GOI.

The Committee approved the State Action Plan (SAP) for Rs.833.00 lakhs for treating an additional area of 1375 ha in seven districts of the State for the year 2017-18 and directed the Department to co-ordinate with the concerned Division at GoI for release of balance funds of 2016-17 (i.e.Rs.250.00 lakhs) and for approval of 2017-18 State Action Plan for Rs.833.00 lakhs

- i) Geo-tagging of RKVY assets: RKVY is operational since 2007-08 & lot of infrastructure has been created under RKVY funding. So it is important that these infrastructures are geo-tagged. In this initiative, a mobile app using Bhuvan platform has been developed. Departments/Institutions to ensure that infrastructure created in their projects are geo-tagged using this mobile application.
- **ii) RDMIS updation:** The Committee instructed Department/Institutions to update the monthly progress and successes stories in RDMIS. It was suggested that reminders as SMS alerts (or) E-mails should be embedded in the MIS for monitoring the updation.

Important decisions taken in the meeting:

- Departments/Institutions to ensure that there is no parking of RKVY funds and to compulsorily utilize funds for the projects for which they were approved.
- Departments /Institutions to expedite utilization of balance funds of 2016-17 and submit progress report and Utilization Certificate immediately.
- All the projects to be implemented in accordance with the Operational guidelines of RKVY, 2014
- Cost norms and financial assistance in similar Govt. of India/State Govt. Schemes/Programmes shall be followed.
- Finance Dept. to revise the State budget allocation under SCSP & TSP components in accordance with GOI allocation.
- Depts. to submit project proposals for utilisation of funds allocated under SCSP & TSP components.
- A Sub- Committee under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner including Secretary(Expenditure), Finance Dept., Secretary, Planning & Secretary Agri. to screen the project proposals for utilisation of allocation under SCSP & TSP components.
- The Sub-Committee to submit this list of projects for approval of the Chairman, RKVY SLSC.
- DPR of the projects for which funds have been reallocated, projects in the additional list to be submitted immediately for further submission to GOI/ICAR.
- These projects to be further implemented as per GOI/ICAR observations.

- For all Research projects, approval of ICAR has to be obtained before implementing the projects and the observations should be duly attended.
- Project Completion Reports and information in other prescribed formats to be submitted to RKVY Cell and the same to be updated in RDMIS.
