Minutes of the 22nd State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY held on 07.06.2017 at 10.30 A.M. in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha

The 22nd State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY was held on 07.06.2017 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat at 10.30 A.M. The list of members & other participants who attended the meeting is placed at **Annexure-I**.

At the outset Principal Secretary to Govt., Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment Department welcomed the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC, Joint Secretary, DAC & FW, GoI as well as other members present in the meeting. He gave an overview of the scheme.

A power point presentation on the agenda wise information was made by the Addl. Secretary (RKVY). The details of the discussion are as follows:

(1) Confirmation of minutes of the last meeting of SLSC held on 27.01.2017

The minutes of the meeting of 21st SLSC held on 27.01.2017 were circulated to all the members vide Agriculture Department letter No.2522/Ag. Dt.17.02.2017. Since no comments were received, SLSC confirmed the minutes of the meeting of 21st SLSC.

(2) Physical status of the projects from 2007-08 to 2016-17

Principal Secretary, Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment informed that 615 nos. of projects have been implemented since inception of RKVY scheme, out of which 379 nos of projects have been completed and uploaded in RDMIS. The Chief Secretary and Chairman, SLSC directed the implementing agencies to submit project completion details of the completed projects immediately for uploading in RDMIS failing which release of fund for other ongoing projects of the concerned implementing agencies will be with-held.

Further it was informed to the house that steps have been taken for Geo tagging of the assets/infrastructures created under RKVY in the State since inception of scheme. For this purpose necessary training of trainers was made to all the implementing agencies involving Scientist of NRSC, Hyderabad & representative of GoI. By this time all the implementing agencies have been trained for Geo tagging of the RKVY assets and registration of data provider for the State & District Sector have been completed. All the implementing agencies are instructed to upload complete photograph of the assets since inception of RKVY along with information of the project in Bhuban portal. Till date, 813 nos of assets have been geo tagged out of which 201 nos are moderated and rest are to be moderated soon.

· (3) A) Financial progress under RKVY for 2007- 08 to 2015-16

The full Utilization Certificates for fund received during 2007-08 to 2014-15 have been submitted to GoI and squared up the accounts for these years.

During the year 2015-16, an amount of Rs.49208.00 lakh has been received against the allocated amount of the Rs.49930.00 lakh and U.Cs for an amount of Rs. 48296.25 lakh including C.S & S.S have been submitted to GoI leaving a balance amount of Rs.258.75 lakh is pending against GoI release which will be submitted very soon. The Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC advised all the department/implementing agencies to submit the balance U.Cs within a week to square up the accounts of 2015-16.

B) Financial Position for 2016-17

For the year 2016-17, an amount of Rs.55818.32 lakh has been released to the implementing agencies which includes Rs.33491.00 lakh as C.S & Rs.22327.32 lakh as S.S, out of which U.Cs of Rs.23781.24 lakh have been submitted to GoI. The Chairman advised all the department/implementing agencies to submit the balance U.Cs as soon as possible to unable the State for getting the 2nd installment release by GoI.

(4) Discussion on Project Proposals for Sanction in the SLSC.

(A) Ongoing Projects of Previous year for implementation during 2017-18:

About 134 nos of ongoing projects of previous year which are mostly multiyear in nature are to be implemented during the current year. The requirement of fund for implementation of those ongoing projects for the year 2017-18 is Rs. 20688.53 lakh. The Committee approved this proposal for implementation of ongoing projects during the current financial year 2017-18. The list of those ongoing projects is given in Annexure –II.

(B) BGREI:

For the year 2017-18, the GoI have allocated an amount of Rs 122.12 crores including CS & SS for implementation of BGREI programme in the State. The DA & FP (O) has placed the Action Plan on BGREI programme with a project cost of Rs 122.12 crores before the Committee which was discussed and approved. The same Action Plan is may be sent immediately to GoI for further action at their end.

5. Discussion on new project proposals

The following New Project proposals recommended by SLPSC were thoroughly discussed in the meeting with reference to comments/ observations of GoI and the decisions were taken as follows.

Hound

(A) <u>DA & FP (O)</u>

1) Crop insurance decision support system with Technology and field based Information Products and Services (CIDSS), Odisha with the cost of Rs. 59.21 lakh.

This project was discussed by the Committee with reference to the comments of GoI and the Committee approved the project with a suggestion to follow ATMA Cost Norm for Exposure visit and Training Component.

2) Strengthening & Renovation of State Seed Testing Laboratory, Bhubaneswar the cost of Rs. 745.82 lakh.

This project was discussed thoroughly by the Committee and the Committee approved the project as per the Comments of Seed Division of GoI.

- 3) E-pest surveillance & pest management 2017-18 with the cost of Rs. 248.50 lakh.

 The Committee discussed the project in detail in respect to GoI Comments and approved the project.
- 4) Setting up of State Bio pesticide Laboratory with the cost of Rs. 277.65 lakh.
- 5) Setting up of Biological Control Laboratory with the cost of Rs. 531.18 lakh.

 The above 2 projects at Sl. No. 4 & 5 were discussed by the SLSC with reference to

the Comments of Plant Protection Division of GoI. The Committee approved the project as per SMPMA Norm.

6) Promotion of Portable Solar Photovoltaic (SPV) Powered Pump Sets for Energisation of Dug Wells & Shallow Tube Wells in Difficult Areas of Odisha with the cost of Rs. 680.00 lakh.

This proposal was discussed by the Committee with reference to the GoI. As regards to the comments or observation of GoI, the proposed of Solar Pump with low capacity i.e. 0.5 HP for irrigation purpose may not be viable. However, the Committee felt the justification for use of 0.5 HP Pump set as NABARD has been financing the scheme with a subsidy component from GoI project for use of marginal & small farmers in the State. The SLSC approved the project proposal in principle with the suggestion that the scheme may be based on the scheme financed by NABARD with subsidy from GoI.

- 7) Establishment of Mini Soil Testing Laboratory (Mridaparikshyalaya) at all Block level (FIAC) with the cost of Rs. 1200.00 lakh.
- 8) Establishment of State Organic Fertilizer Testing Laboratory with the cost of Rs. 125.20 lakh.
- 9) Strengthening of quality control in pesticide formulation with the cost of Rs. 73.24 lakh.

The above 3 proposals at Sl. No. 7, 8 & 9 have been discussed detail by the Committee with response to the GoI comments and the SLSC approved the above 3 projects which are supported as per SHM norms & RKVY Guideline.

- production, access and supply of improved varieties of seeds with the cost of Rs. 193.74 lakh.
- 11) Integrating farming systems model for income enhancement of small and marginal farmers in Koraput region with the cost of Rs. 162.21 lakh.

The above 2 project proposals at Sl. No. 10 & 11 were discussed in detail by the Committee with reference to comments of GoI and the Committee approved these two projects in principle with a suggestion to recast the project as per the comments/observations of GoI i.e. the recurring expenses & institutional charges.

12) Enabling Small Holders to Produce and Consume more Nutritious Food through Agroforestry Systems in Odisha with the cost of Rs. 1918.95 lakh.

The project was discussed by the Committee with reference to comments of GoI. Originally, this project was recommended for 4 districts namely; Angul, Deogarh, Sambalpur and Keonjhar. Subsequently it has been decided that the project should be implemented in 30 identified GPs of 2 districts namely; Nuapara and Bolangir instead of those 4 districts with an intention to arrest the migration of labourers. The project was supported by GoI as per ATMA cost norms. The Committee approved the project with a suggestion that the training, awareness and extension activities should be carried out as per the comments of Extension Division of GoI. Further the Committee suggested that the collaborating agency i.e. ICRAF should sign an MOU with Director, Agriculture & FP (O) soon for implementation of the project.

Director Horticulture

13) Development of Farms and Nurseries on Horticulture with the cost of Rs. 616.18 lakh.

The Committee discussed the project proposal in detail with reference to the comments of GoI and approved the project which is supported as per MIDH norms.

14) Establishment of Centre of Excellence on Horticulture with the cost of Rs. 1100.00 lakh.

The proposal was discussed in detail with reference to the comments of GoI and the Committee approved the project in principle with a suggestion to rename the project as "Establishment of Resource-cum-Training Centre for Commercial Horticulture. The Director, Horticulture is requested to submit the revised project proposal as soon as possible.

e-Pest Surveillance and Pest Management of Vegetables Crop with the cost of Rs. 347.00 lakh.

The project discussed in detail with reference to Comments of GoI and the SLSC approved the project keeping in view the observations/ comments received from the respective division of GoI. However, the Training Component should be followed as per ATMA Norms.

16) Cold Store Centric Potato Incentivization Programme in Odisha with the cost of Rs. 378.75 lakh.

The project proposal was discussed in detail with reference to the comments of GoI. The Committee approved the project as per the Comments of GoI.

The SLSC discussed the above 2 nos of project proposals at Sl No. 33 & 34 in detail with reference to comments of GoI and the Committee approved the project, keeping in view the observation/comments received from the respective division of GoI.

- Whenever the project have been approved keeping in view suggestions /views of GoI, these should be incorporated in the project proposal and cost revised accordingly.
 Sanction of fund should be as per revised cost.

In the concluding session, the Joint Secretary, RKVY, GoI informed the house that, after the EFC meeting at GoI level, the new guideline of RKVY will be released very soon for implementation of RKVY Projects. The Scheme includes 50% of the outlay of the fund will be ear marked for Infrastructure and 20 % fund for flexi fund towards innovative project and 30% for production link with value addition and marketing. The State should come forward in collaboration with entrepreneurs and the F.P.Os for value addition and marketing linkage of

Agricultural produce. The State should come forward with the projects like; Agri-business and Agri-tourism in PPP Mode. In coming days the State should formulate such type of project proposal under RKVY as per the template issued earlier. Further, the Finance Secretary informed the house that, GST will be implemented from July 1st in our State. Accordingly, many of the services may be exempted from the tax. All the departments should go through the web site for further action.







