
The meeting was presided over by the Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan. The list of participants is enclosed at Annexure A.

Principal Secretary, (Agriculture & Horticulture) GOR welcomed all the members of committee and explained the purpose of convening meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC). For the 13<sup>th</sup> SLSC meeting, Smt. A. Neerja, Jt. Secretary, RKVY GOI on behalf of Ministry of Agriculture& Farmers Welfare was present in the meeting.

The agenda items were discussed and the following decisions were taken:-

- Agenda Item No. 1: Confirmation of minutes of last meeting held on 23-06-2016 (12<sup>th</sup> meeting):
   The Committee confirmed the minutes of the 12<sup>th</sup> SLSC meeting held on 23.06.2016.
- 2. Agenda Item No.2: Financial progress under RKVY during 2016-17: The Department-wise and scheme wise expenditure of ₹ 49941.00 Lacs incurred during the year 2016-17 against the available funds of ₹ 51403.00 Lacs was placed before the Committee. GOI has revalidated the unspent balance of ₹ 877.40 lacs. The committee noted the same.
- Agenda item no. 3: Letters from Govt. of India: Ministry of Agriculture and farmers welfare, Department of Agriculture, cooperation & farmers welfare, GOI has issued letters regarding allocation to State, Inter State allocation for the year 2017-18 & Revalidation of Unspent balance as on 1-4-2017 from the releases made during 2016-17 were noted by SLSC.
- 3. Agenda item No 4- New Project Proposals for 2017-18:

  Agenda was discussed in detail and following decisions were taken:



- Principal Secretary, Agriculture informed that, GOI comments/ observations have been received. Most of the projects except following projects are supported by GOI under RKVY.
  - I. Assistance for old poly house structure programme,
  - II. Fish input cost subsidy,
  - III. Demonstation of 4D Aqua technology
  - IV. Holistic approach for socio economic upliftment of tribal stakeholders of southern Rajasthan through Amelioration of infertility infections and Zoonotic and Animal waste management.
- ii. New Projects proposals for total cost of ₹ 27360.37 Lacs out of which Rs. 11378.93 lacs only to be spent in year 2017-18. Were presented before SLSC. New projects for total cost of Rs. 26840.65 lacs out of which Rs. 11222.43 lacs for 2017-18 have been approved by SLSC. Details are given at Annexure-I
- iii. Following decisions were taken in the SLSC:
  - Project for Assistance for old poly house structure programme not approved.
  - ii. SLSC has approved the project on Demonstration of 4D Aqua technology.
  - iii. Boundary wall in the project "Stengthening of Various Rajhans Nurseries" may not be constructed through RKVY.
  - iv. Medicinal Plants in the project "Centre of Excellence for medicinal plants at Bhilwara" may be taken with the consultation of Ayurved Deptt.
  - v. Project on Construction of Bore well at fish farm Kaithoon (Kota) not approved.
  - vi. Project on Fish input subsidy not approved.
  - vii. Projects on Watershed treatment in the Catchment of R.V.P. were provisionally approved subject to the condition that activities to be in convergence with PMKSY & CAMPA without duplication.





  - ix. Project on Promotion and Feasibility Assessment of Solar Powered
     Pump by Mechanizing Wells at Non-Electrifiable Areas not approved
  - x. Project on Development of heat resilient Indian mustard genotypes to enhance its productivity in semi-arid conditions of Rajasthan not approved
  - xi. Project on Holistic Approach for Socio economic Up-liftment of Tribal Stockholders of Southern Rajasthan through Amelioration of Infertility study of Infectious and Zoonotic Diseases and Animal Waste Management not approved.
- 4. Agenda item No. 5 Requirement of funds for on-going projects

  during 2017-18: Requirement of funds for on-going projects of Rs. 35662.29

  Lacs were approved for the year 2017-18 as per the guidelines of RKVY. The project wise details are at Annexure –II.
- 5. Agenda item no. 6: Clearance of Committed Liabilities of on-going projects of 2016-17 during current financial year 2017-18: The SLSC approved the funds for projects where Committed liabilities of ₹ 6991.55 Lacs have been incurred before 31st March 2017. The project wise details are enclosed as Annexure-III.
- Agenda item No. 7 -Proposal for Administrative cost under RKVY for 2017-18: Proposal for Administrative cost ₹ 400.00 lacs under RKVY were approved as per details at Annexure IV.

ATMA -SEWP plan for 2017-18 for ₹ 8993.31 Lacs was approved by SLSC as per ATMA guidelines and norms. The details are given at Annexure-VI.





- 1. Heat stress tolerance both at seedling as well as terminal stage is important in Indian mustard. Therefore, clear cut objectives and work plan should be defined keeping in mind stage of heat stress. Accordingly parameters may be selected.
- 2. Strain is a pre release material at advance stage. It must be ensured that which AICRP-RM centre/DRMR is going to share the promising material. In my view, without Agreement no centre will share the material. This is an issue which should be addresses in the proposal.
- 3. How farmers will be benefitted by this study directly as it is more of basic work which will be utilized by breeders in screening of heat tolerant material?
- 4. Capacity development of personnals engaged in the project is good and HRD money is justified but what is the need of the money for farmers training and on which aspect?
- 5. The title of the project is little bit ambiguous in terms of the climate resilient strains. It should be clear that the project is aimed at development of climate resilient strains or using the already developed material, if so then detail of strains be given.
