MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE
(SLSC) MEETING HELD IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF CHIEF
SECRETARY 5th FLOOR, BLOCK-II, CIVIL SECRETARIAT, ITANAGAR
ON 25th July' 2018

1. A meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) to approve the project proposals received under Rashtriya Krishi Vikash Yojana- Remunerative approach for Agriculture and Allied Sectors Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR) for the year 2018-2019 was convened on 25/07/2018 under the chairmanship of Shri Satya Gopal, IAS, Chief Secretary –cum-Chairman, State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC), Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh in the Conference Hall of Chief Secretary, 5th Floor, Block No. II, Civil Secretariat, Itanagar. The list of members who attended the meeting is annexed at **APPENDIX- A**.
2. The Secretary (Agriculture/Horticulture) Mimum Tayeng, IAS welcomed all the members present in the meeting and informed them regarding decisions taken in the State Level Project Screening Committee (SLPSC) meeting held on 04/05/2018 in the Conference Hall of Commissioner (Finance), Civil Secretariat, Itanagar under the chairmanship of the Agriculture Production Commissioner, Govt of Arunachal Pradesh. The members were informed that the project proposals which are approved by the SLSC should only be submitted to the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India under all RKVY-RAFTAAR scheme as this was a mandatory requirement prescribed by the GoI under the guidelines of the said scheme.
3. Director (Agriculture)-cum-State Nodal Officer (RKVY), Shri Anong Lego informed that the flagship Centrally Sponsored Schemes of RKVY has been modified as RKVY-RAFTAAR and that the new operational Guidelines for implementation of the RKVY- RAFTAAR during 2017-2018 to 2019-2020 have been issued with emphasis on pre and post-harvest infrastructure in lieu of the earlier provision of Production Growth, Infrastructure and flexi-fund for creation of asset. It was pointed out that since Arunachal Pradesh has huge reserves of cultivable land, significant emphasis should be laid on expanding the area under cultivation and achieving a very high growth rate in production and productivity. It was also pointed out that approximately 14% of the total potential cultivable area is under cultivation at present. Further, the volume of crop production needs to be increased manifold in order to meet the demand being generated by the post-harvest value addition activities such as food processing. The Director informed that the reply/clarification in respect of the observations raised by the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, GoI in the pre-SLSC meeting held on 20th July 2018 at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi could not be submitted by the Department of Agriculture & allied departments, Government of Arunachal Pradesh since the said observations of the DAC&FW, GoI were received on the same day i.e. on 25th July 2018.
4. Shri Idar Nyori, ADO, Directorate of Agriculture made a power point presentation on the projects proposed to be executed during this financial year 2018-19. He also informed that the Detailed Project Reports (DPR) have also been approved by the State level Project Screening Committee earlier. A video clip on the success story of King Chili Cultivation implemented under RKVY as an alternative to Opium and Cannabis Cultivation was shown to the members in the meeting. It was also informed that the funds received by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh under RKVY have shown a declining trend and that only 25% of the fund earmarked as tentative allocation for the state of Arunachal Pradesh was received during 2017-2018. It was reiterated that the delay in submitting Utilization Certificates by respective departments of Government of Arunachal Pradesh under RKVY was one of the main contributing factors for non-release of 100% fund earmarked for the state of Arunachal Pradesh under RKVY during 2017-18.
5. The Chairman made the following observations:
 - (i) The Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) of the projects which are to be executed under RKVY-RAFTAAR should be got approved by the SLPSC and SLSC before submitting the same to the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, GoI.

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- (ii) It should be ensured by all the respective Deputy Commissioners and Deputy Directors that the beneficiaries selected under the projects of RKVY should necessarily be small and marginal farmers only and that the list of the beneficiaries consisting of small and marginal farmers should be certified by the respective Deputy Director, Agriculture and Deputy Commissioner of each district. For selection of beneficiaries among the small and marginal farmers, applications be sought in the prescribed format and thereafter the final list of beneficiaries be selected by lottery system which should be conducted by Deputy Commissioner in the most transparent manner under his personal supervision.
- (iii) The project proposals which have been submitted under RKVY should be got approved by the concerned Hon'ble Minister of the department by the concerned Secretary.
- (iv) The estimates in the DPR's should be prepared on the basis of the SOR prescribed and notified by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. In this regard, a certificate signed by the concerned Superintending Engineer and countersigned by the Chief Engineer of the executing department should be placed on record in the DPR certifying that the estimates have been prepared strictly as per the SOR prescribed and notified by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
- (v) The contingency charges / administrative expenses in respect of each project proposal should be reduced to only 1% and that the approval of concerned Secretary/Commissioner should be obtained for the activities / heads on which the said administrative expenses / contingency charges would be spent in respect of each project proposal sanctioned under RKVY-RAFTAAR.
- (vi) All concerned departments should prioritize and shortlist the project proposals under RKVY within the tentative allocation of fund specified by the Govt. of India under RKVY-RAFTAAR for the state of Arunachal Pradesh.
- (vii) Non Duplicacy Certificate from executing engineer countersigned by Superintending Engineer / Chief Engineer should also be furnished and placed on record.
- (viii) All the payments of any kind of financial assistance under RKVY-RAFTAAR to the beneficiaries shall have to be made through DBT mode only.
- (ix) It was reiterated that all activities proposed to be undertaken, under RKVY-RAFTAAR during the Year 2018-19 should be monitored properly and that a Fool-proof monitoring and reviewing system should be put in place and proper records should be maintained, so that the funds are utilized strictly for the purpose for which they have been granted. It was emphasized that Geo-Tagging of all the activities should be made without fail. It was also decided that all plantation activities to be taken up under the RKVY-RAFTAAR be got inspected by Mobile/Flying squad for verifying the plantations undertaken in the project proposal. Mobile/ Flying squads should be raised by each Deputy Commissioner. It was also decided that the Flying squad at the Head Quarter of the department should also be constituted.
- (x) It was further decided that the concerned Deputy Director, Agriculture should give a monthly report of all the inspections conducted during the month by the Mobile Squads/ Officers and the gaps/ loopholes/ discrepancies/ irregularities/ illegalities etc. noticed, if any, by the inspecting officers. The Deputy Director, Agriculture should also indicate as to what corrective action he has taken to plug the gaps/ loopholes/ discrepancies/ irregularities/ illegalities noticed during inspections. The report should also contain status, action taken and progress made in implementation of RKVY-RAFTAAR. The report in respect of inspections conducted by the Deputy Director, Agriculture should be submitted to the PS to Hon'ble Minister, Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary & Dairy Development, Handicrafts & Textiles, Soil & Water Conservations, RWD and Secretary to HCM for their kind information and directions, if any.
- (xi) The norms, conditions, guidelines etc prescribed by the Government of India & State Government in this regard should be followed & adhered to in letter & spirit without fail by all Officers of Departments of Agriculture, Horticulture,

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Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary & Dairy Development, Handicrafts & Textiles and Soil & Water Conservations, RWD.

- (xii) A Time Bound Action Plan and a PERT chart should be prepared and adhered to by all the concerned officers of the implementing departments. An OM should also be issued to all concerned officers in this regard by the Secretary of the implementing / executing departments to ensure that the timelines indicated in the pert chart are adhered to without fail.
- (xiii) All the activities undertaken under RKVY-RAFTAAR should be monitored and supervised through a robust mechanism to ensure proper implementation of approved item of works. A total transparent system should be put in place so as to eliminate any leakages/ gaps/ corrupt-practices in the system.
- (xiv) It was also reiterated that all the officers and officials of the concerned Departments of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh should ensure that all the conditions & provisions prescribed under GFR, DFPR etc, all the Financial Rules & Regulations, all the guidelines, conditions & directives etc prescribed in the orders/notifications/ letters/ OMs etc issued by the CVC, Ministry of Finance, GoI, Ministry of Agriculture GoI and Ministry of DoNER and any other administrative Ministries of GoI and Government of Arunachal Pradesh in this regard are followed and adhered to in letter and spirit without fail. It was decided that all the officers & officials should work in a team spirit for achieving the mission of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh for providing a totally corruption free transparent system and increasing the overall production and productivity by bringing more and more land under cultivation.
6. Proceeding on to the project proposals to be undertaken by the Agriculture Department, the following schemes were approved by the SLSC with the proviso that the DPRs/estimates should be re-cast as per the APSR 2018 and a certificate duly signed by Superintending Engineer and countersigned by Chief Engineer to that effect be placed on record in the DPR without fail:-
- Input Storage Godowns for newly created districts of Kamle, Siang, Lower Siang, Longding, Kurung Kumey, Kradadi @ Rs.25.00 lakh each.
 - PD (ATMA)-cum- DDA office and training hall in district of Kamle, Siang, Lower Siang @ Rs 80.00 lakh each.
 - Construction of block ATMA-BTT Cell at Ziro-I, Basar, Deomali, Miao, Chongkham, Roing, Mebo, Mariyang, Menchuka, Hawaii, Sagalee, Seppa, Tawang, Koloriang, Palin, Daporijo under PD ATMA @ Rs.20.00 lakh for 16 districts.
 - Agriculture and allied Produce Collection Centre at Deomali, Mahadevpur, Shantipur, Ruksin, Likabali, Kimin, Banderdewa, Hollongi, Bhalukpong, Palin, Sangram, Dumporijo @ Rs.20.00 lakh each for 12 districts.
 - Proposal for Establishment of Vermi Compost Unit was approved subject to following the MIDH cost norms.
 - Under Post Harvest Infrastructure and Assets component, proposal for Market Complex at Kanubari, in Longding District was approved as per the last SLSC decision.
 - Development of wayside market shed for selling of agriculture and allied produces in potential areas @ 3.00 lakh each in 66 places. It was also suggested by the Chairman that the Way Side Market Sheds could also be used as milk distribution and collection centre under the Dairy Development scheme of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. The Agriculture department should intimate the AHV & DD Department of the location of such units.
 - Under Value Addition linked Production Infrastructure and Assets component, the proposal for Ginger/Turmeric Dryer and Processing Unit at Govt. Seed Farm, Sonajuli and Govt. Farms at Tezu/Bolung/Jumlo @ Rs.27.79 lakh each was approved.
 - Power Operated Mustard & Millet Processing Unit with complete accessories and shed @ Rs.3.23 lakh each on Pilot Project basis was approved subject to availability of fund.

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- j. Under Flexi fund, proposal for distribution of Gender Friendly Hand Tool Kits in all districts was approved.
- k. Under special sub-schemes Reclamation of Acidic Soils, the sub-scheme being a national priority, the proposals were approved as proposed.
- l. The project proposal to top-up the existing King Chilly & Cardamom Drying Unit by incorporating the additional component of Ginger/ Turmeric Drying and Processing Unit of M/S Arunachal Spices Unit at Namsai, under the Innovation and Agri- Entrepreneur Development component was approved with the condition that the number and details of farmers being benefited under this proposal should be furnished to the Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
- m. The proposal to conduct District Level Expo-cum-Sale to showcase agriculture and allied produce @ Rs.10.00 lakh per district in 14 districts was approved.
- n. Additional fund of Rs. 12.60 lakh allocated for Construction of NADEP Pits in Aspirational District - Namsai under Krishi Kalyan Abhiyan, 2018 was approved. The cost per unit was fixed at Rs.12,600/- in lieu of the proposed Rs.14,000/- per unit on 50:50 cost sharing basis with subsidy limited to Rs.6,300/- per unit only. The DDA Namsai should ensure that the beneficiaries under this project are only small & marginal farmers without fail and a certificate to that effect be submitted on record.

The details of project approved under Agriculture Department under RKVY-RAFTAAR have been placed at **Annexure-I**.

7. RATIFICATION OF STATE EXTENSION WORK PLAN (SEWP) 2018-19:

- a) The SLSC was informed that, as per Govt. of India's instructions the SEWP 2018-19 for ATMA under Sub Mission on Agriculture Extension (SMAE) was approved 'IN PRINCIPLE' by the Chief Secretary (I/C) and sent to Govt. of India so that 1st Instalment of funds was released in time so as to meet the committed expenditure on deployed manpower.
- b) The Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman(SLSC) opined that the State Extension Work Plan (SEWP) 2018-19 should stipulate activities under ATMA within the tentative allocation of fund specified by Govt. of India for the current financial year 2018-19 amounting to Rs.1238.76 Lakh (Rs.1114.88 Lakh Central Share + Rs.123.88 Lakh State Share) only.
- c) It was decided that the SEWP be prepared showing district wise division of funds along with the activities proposed within the tentative allocation of funds earmarked by Govt. of India for current financial year 2018-19.
- d) The district wise SEWP 2018-19 received under the ATMA schemes by the Agriculture Department was compiled by consolidating the District Agriculture Action Plans (DAAP) received from 22 Districts having 109 Blocks, for an amount of Rs.1238.76 Lakh which was within the tentative allocated fund earmarked by Govt. of India for SMAE during the current financial year 2018-19. **(ANNEXURE VIII)**
- e) Further, it was also decided to explore measures to initiate regular payment of remuneration / wages on monthly basis to all the contractual functionaries engaged under ATMA programme in the Deptt. of Agriculture, since, non-payment of salaries on monthly basis adversely affects the work efficiency of engaged field functionaries and hinders their optimal performance.

8. HORTICULTURE:

After detailed deliberations on the project proposals submitted by the Department of Horticulture under RKVY-RAFTAAR for the year 2018-19, following proposals were approved:-

- a. For projects under Pre-Harvest Structure, beneficiaries to be selected from among small and marginal farmers.
- b. The project for water harvesting system for storage of water was dropped on the request of the Horticulture department in view of the fact that similar schemes were being executed under PMKSY.

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- c. All 3 (Three) projects under Post-Harvest Structure were approved with the condition that Pack-houses to be provided to those SHGs which are performing very well and recommended by NABARD.
- d. Project for providing Electric Driers under Value Added linked production project was approved.
- e. Projects proposed under Flexi Fund: Area Expansion programme of Kiwi Fruit was dropped as the project was of 3 (three) years duration and as per Ministry's directions only those projects which could be completed by 2020 are to be taken up under RKVY-RAAFTAR. Project on Promoting Vegetables as cash crop in temperate belts was approved and it was decided that only those individual beneficiaries should be selected who have less than or equal to one hectare of land.
- f. Project proposed by Department under Innovation and Agri. Entrepreneur Development was not approved by SLSC and hence dropped.

The details of projects approved under Horticulture Department can be perused at **Annexure-II.**

9. AHV & DD DEPARTMENT:

- a. While discussing the project proposal submitted by AHV & DD Department, (i) for strengthening the Pig Breeding Farm, Wessang, E/Kameng district, it was observed that the Govt. approved rate for exotic piglets is required to be furnished and the project may be implemented as per the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) cost norm. (ii) Proposal for beneficiary oriented piggery unit under Value Additional Linked Production component and (iii) Farmers/ Officers training and Exposure visit under Innovation and Agri-Entrepreneur Development was not supported as per DAC&FW observation. However, the Chief Secretary-cum- Chairman (SLSC) suggested that the AHV&DD department may make a request to the Secretary (DONER) for consideration of the proposal, citing rejection of the said scheme by DAC&FW.

The details of projects approved under AHV&DD can be perused at **Annexure-III.**

10. FISHERIES:

- a. Proposal under pre-harvest component was approved as per the Blue Revolution Norm of the DAC&FW. Project proposed under post harvest and value addition linked production infrastructure were not approved. Proposal for small scale fish canning unit was also not approved. Proposal for development of Paddy-cum-Fish Culture was approved.
- b. Blue Revolution cost norm should be followed for all the proposals and all the conditions specified and prescribed by the Chairman, SLSC above in para 5 above should be followed and adhered to without fail.

Approved projects under the Fisheries department can be perused at **Annexure-IV.**

11. SERICULTURE:

The Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman (SLSC) took a serious note of the absence of Director, Handloom Textile and Handicrafts (HT&H), GoAP in the SLSC meeting and instructed Secretary, Agriculture / Horticulture to issue a show cause notice to him for initiating disciplinary proceedings against him for not attending the SLSC meeting. In absence of comments from the Sericulture division during pre-SLSC meeting at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi or relevant observations from the DAC&FW, there was limited discussion on the project proposals of the Sericulture sector. However, the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman (SLSC) suggested that the department should prioritize the projects in order to accommodate the same within the tentative funds allocated under RKVY-RAFTAAR during 2018-19 by the Government of India.

The approved projects under Sericulture can be perused at **Annexure-V.**

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12. SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION (RWD):

After detailed deliberations, the SLSC approved the proposals placed at **Annexure-VI**.

13. COOPERATION:

The Power Point Presentation was made before the house. Questions / queries were raised by the Chairman in respect of functioning of the Cooperative Societies and as to whether they were holding AGM meeting, conducting elections, auditing the accounts etc. as per the rules & provisions of the relevant Act. The representative of the Cooperation Department stated that the Cooperative Societies as were functioning as per rules & legal provisions and were conducting elections, audit, AGM etc. as per the provisions prescribed in the Act & Rules. After detailed deliberations the department was advised to complete the ongoing projects as directed by DAC & FW since they have to be completed by 2019-2020

The projects approved by the SLSC can be perused at **Annexure-VII**.

It was reiterated that all the conditions specified / prescribed by Chairman in para 5 above should be followed and adhered to in letter and spirit without fail by all the departments.


