# Minutes of the 9th State Level Sanction Committee Meeting of RKVY-RAFTAAR held on 26-02-2021 through Webinar at 11:00 AM in the Chief Secretary Conference Hall, 9th Floor, Telangana Secretariat, Hyderabad.

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The 9th State Level Sanction Committee meeting of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana –Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied sector Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR) scheme of Telangana State was held under the Chairmanship of Sri Somesh Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary/ Chairman SLSC, RKVY, Government of Telangana on 26-02-2021 through Webinar in the Chief Secretary Conference Hall, 9th Floor, Secretariat, Hyderabad, Telangana State, to sanction the projects of Agriculture and Allied Sectors for implementation during the year 2020-21.

The Government of India representative, Dr. K. Ponnusamy, Director, Directorate of Oilseeds Development, Govt. of India, Members of State Level Sanction Committee. (SLSC), HODs, Officers of Agriculture and Allied Sectors have attended the meeting. The list of officers attended the meeting is shown in *Annexure*.

At the outset Sri. Dr. B. Janardhan Reddy, IAS, APC & Secretary (Agril. & Coop)/ Vice Chairman & Member Secretary, SLSC, RKVY welcomed all the participants to the meeting.

The Vice Chairman & Member Secretary, SLSC, RKVY has explained in detail on the RKVY-RAFTAAR funding pattern and scheme objectives.

#### 1. Progress of 2019-20 RKVY Projects:

The Vice Chairman & Member Secretary, SLSC, RKVY has informed that, an amount of Rs. 432.95 Crores (Central Share Rs.259.77 Crores and State share Rs.173.18 Crores) under Normal RKVY, Rs.0.1745 Cr. (Central Share Rs 0.1047 Cr. under and State Share Rs.0.0698 Cr) towards Crop Diversification Programme (CDP) and Rs.2.1667 Cr (Central Share Rs 1.30 Cr. under and State Share Rs.0.8667 Cr) towards Animal Health under Sub-scheme of RKVY allocated to the Telangana State during the year 2019-20.

The Government of Telangana has issued BROs amounting to Rs.235.3020 Crores under RKVY-RAFTAAR scheme during 2019-20 for implementation of SLSC approved projects.

Bills for Rs. 235.3020 Cr submitted to Treasury during 2019-20 out of which only Rs.10.843 Cr was cleared by the Finance Department of Telangana State. The details of the Expenditure for Rs.10.843 Cr are as shown hereunder:
