**MEETING MINUTES OF STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (SLSC), 2021-22 OF  
RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA – REMUNERATIVE APPROACHES FOR  
AGRICULTURE & ALLIED SECTOR REJUVENATION (RKVY – RAFTAAR) , ASSAM**

**Date & Time :- 26<sup>th</sup> August' 2021 at 9.30 am.**

**Venue :- Conference Hall of Chief Secretary to Government of Assam, Janata Bhawan,

The meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Sri Jishnu Baruah, IAS, Chief Secretary, Govt. of Assam in presence of Sri Ravi.S.Prasad, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary & Agriculture Production Commissioner to Govt. of Assam cum Vice Chairman of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting and Sri Anand Krishan, IAS, Director (RKVY), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Department of Agriculture, Co-operation & Farmers Welfare, New Delhi, the representative from the Govt. of India also attended SLSC meeting virtually.

Sri Ravi.S.Prasad, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary & Agriculture Production Commissioner to the Govt. of Assam welcomed the members present in the meeting.

Sri Vinod Seshan, IAS, Secretary, Agriculture cum Director of Agriculture, Assam with due permission from the chair has given a brief presentation on the proposals under RKVY- RAFTAAR, 2021-22 before the house for approval.

The Director of Agriculture has informed the house that, GOI has given an allocation of Rs 159.52 crores for the financial year 2021-22. Therefore, including the proportionate State Share, the total allocation for the year 2021-22 was Rs. 177.24 crores. Accordingly, as per the guideline the department has submitted a proposal of Rs. 303.47 Crores to GOI for approval.

The Director of Agriculture, Assam has opined that the GOI has already given the views/observations on the project proposal for RKVY –RAFTAAR 2021-22. As per the opinion of GOI, proposals have been supported for Rs.203.07 Cr; comments awaited for 54.72 Cr and other comments for 37.15 Cr. The GOI has declined some proposals amounting Rs.8.54 Cr.



The project proposals were then discussed in detail along with the Power Point presentation by the representatives of the respective departments and after threadbare discussion, the committee decided the following –

1. Assam Agriculture University:

- Three proposals amounting Rs.639.44 lakh was sent to Govt. of India, all were accepted, however comments for one proposal on gene bank of rice amounting Rs.289.00 lakh is awaited
- The other two proposals are to be modified in the light of the comments given by Govt. of India/ ICAR immediately
- The Chairmen SLSC suggested to include quantifiable targets in the projects defining how many farmers/ youths are going to be benefitted at the end of project should be mentioned clearly.
- The Committee after discussion has **approved** the entire proposed amount of Rs.6.3933 Cr including the amount for Gene bank (R.2.89 Cr) which is subject to approval from GOI. The detail of component wise approvals is placed at Annexure-II.

2. Agriculture Department:

- The total proposed amount under Agriculture department was Rs.221.8683 Cr, out of which GOI has supported for Rs.151.8192 Cr, Comments awaited for Rs.33.39 Cr and other comments for modification etc. is for Rs.28.51 Cr.
- As per GOI comments, the committee has also rejected the proposal for Water Wheel Tank (Rs. 1.4994 Cr), Geo Membrane Sheet (Rs. 6.00 Cr) and Primary processing & Basic Value addition of Cocoa beans for Rs. 0.75 Cr.
- The Committee has **approved** all other components proposed by agriculture department amounting Rs. 213.6189 Cr. The detail of component-wise approvals is placed at Annexure-III

3. Animal Husbandry & Veterinary:

- The total proposed amount under Animal husbandry & veterinary Department was Rs. 8.58 Cr, of which GOI has directly supported for Rs. 0.92 Cr. GOI has given other comments (modification) for Rs. 5.60 Cr and comments awaited for 1.91 Cr.
- GOI has declined the skill development programme for farmers amounting Rs. 0.15 Cr.
- The committee after reviewing the comments from GOI and discussion with the representatives of the concerned department has **approved** the proposal for Rs. 8.43 Cr and rejected the component- Skill Development programme for Rs. 0.15 Cr.
- Moreover, under Animal Health Sub-scheme (Rabies Vaccination of Canines), a total of Rs. 0.4702 Cr has also been **approved** by SLSC. The detail component wise approval is placed at Annexure-IV

4. Dairy Development:

- The total proposed amount under various subcomponents of Dairy Department was Rs. 2.10 Cr and the comments from GOI for the entire amount is still awaited.
- The committee has **approved** the proposals of Dairy department for Rs. 2.10 Cr, subject to approvals from GOI. The detail of component wise approval status is placed at Annexure- V

5. Fishery:

- The total proposed amount by Fishery department was Rs.2.10 Cr and GOI has supported the proposals for Rs. 1.8975 Cr. The proposal for Fish Ice box has not been supported by GOI for Rs. 0.2025 Cr
- In line of GOI, the SLSC has **approved** the proposal for Rs.1.8975 Cr, declining the fish ice box component. The detail of approval is placed at Annexure- VI

6. Horticulture & Food Processing:

- The proposal given by Horticulture & Food Processing Directorate was for Rs.18.6303 Cr and the GOI has supported the entire amount to be implemented in the year 2021-22. The SLSC has also supported the same & **approved** the all components as proposed (Rs.18.6303 Cr). The detail of component wise approvals is placed at Annexure -VII

7. Sericulture:

- The amount proposed by Sericulture Directorate was for Rs. 10.7331 Cr and the entire proposal was supported by GOI. The committee has also **approved** the entire proposal for Rs. 10.7331 Cr. The detail of component wise approval is placed at Annexure-VIII

8. Bodoland Territorial Council (BTC):

- The total amount of proposals submitted by BTC was Rs.21.61 Cr of which GOI has supported for Rs.12.8950 Cr, Comments awaited for Rs. 8.09 Cr and suggested for modification for Rs. 0.625 Cr.
- The SLSC after discussion has **approved** the entire proposal for Rs. 21.61 Cr, including the components Plastic Vermibed (Rs.33.00 Lakh) and Oilseed Development programme (Rs.120.00 Cr) which are subject to get clearance from GOI. The detail of approvals is placed at Annexure-IX

9. Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council (KAAC):

- Out of Rs.6.60 Cr proposal submitted by KAAC, GOI has supported Rs.4.8823 Cr and declined the proposal for Arecanut seedling for Rs.0.1362 Cr. The comments awaited for some components is for Rs.1.5815 Cr.
- The SLSC has reviewed the proposal of KAAC and **approved** an amount of Rs.6.0638 Cr rejecting the proposal for Arecanut seedling and Pick-up Van (Rs.0.40 Cr). The detail of approvals for the proposal submitted by KAAC is placed at Annexure- X.

10. North Cachar Hills Autonomous Council (NCHAC):

- The Total amount of proposal submitted by NCHAC was for Rs. 4.8566 Cr. The comments for the entire proposal are still awaited.
- The committee has **approved** the proposed amount by NCHAC for Rs. 4.8566 Cr subject to approval from GOI. The detail of approval is placed at Annexure-XI.


