Agenda Item No.1

Agenda Item No.2

Action Taken Report on the Decisions taken in the Meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) held on 23.04.2013

The Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in the last meeting was presented by the Director General, Agriculture before the Committee.

While discussing on the project "installation of shallow tube-wells along Delhi Branch from RD212000-282636 to save agricultural land from water logging & feasibility study", the Engineer-in-Chief, Irrigation apprised the Committee that the non-scheduled items included in the project were duly sanctioned by the competent authority after following the prescribed procedure. It was, however, desired that the report to this effect may be submitted by the Irrigation Department to the Government of India as well as Agriculture Department, Haryana.

Secondly, the grant shall remain limited to 25% of the total project cost under the "project for construction of 13008 MT capacity HAIC godowns at Ambala, Murthal, CFP Jind and Bhiwani (also in Agenda No.4.2).

The Committee noted the ATR and expressed satisfaction at the outcomes.

Review of Funds Utilization released during 2012-13.

Director General, Agriculture apprised the Committee that as decided in the meeting of SLSC held on 23.4.2013, the GOI was to be requested for revalidation of an amount of ₹ 6009.37 lakh which was calculated on the basis of expenditure statements submitted by various implementing agencies. The above projects of the Department of Agriculture, Haryana were approved subject to the following conditions specific to the projects:

- i) The project "Promotion of Resource Conserving Technologies" was approved in principle. Since there was conflict in the norms of rate of subsidy of 40% set by Govt. of India and the rate of subsidy of 50% proposed by the State Govt., therefore, it was decided that the implementing Department shall submit a proposal to Govt. of India with justification to get the ceiling increased and in the event the ceiling is not increased, the difference in the rate of subsidy may be made-up through State Plan.
- ii) The selection of beneficiaries under Project for "Providing Straw Reaper to the Gaushala during the year 2013-14" shall be made through the 'draw of lots' since the number of eligible applicants is likely to exceed the number of beneficiaries proposed under the project.
- While implementing the project "Reclamation of Saline & Water Logged Soils in Haryana by laying Sub-Surface Drainage System", all the options including scientific study, technology assessment etc should be explored for conversion of saline water to potable water and if needed, a meeting of the concerned Departments/organizations like Haryana Kisan Ayog, CCSHAU, Irrigation Department, Agriculture Department may be called separately in this regard.
- iv) At the request of HLRDC, the project "Reclamation of alkali soils by applying Gypsum Ingredient during the year 2013-14" stands approved at the project cost of ₹ 500 Lakh to facilitate coverage of more area. It was decided to take the worst affected areas first and to make scientific distribution of Gypsum in the Districts where it was actually needed the most on the basis of soil tests/ soil health cards. The project shall be implemented on the previous norms/guidelines.
- v) The project "Promotion of Direct Seeded Rice (DSR)" shall be implemented as per NFSM norms. It was desired that the aspects of higher incidence of weeds, failure/replanting of the crop and undertaking the project in 'cluster approach' may be thoroughly examined for implementation from next Kharif.
- vi) The "Project regarding development of Adarsh Krishi Gram as model village" shall be implemented as per norms approved last year. The cost details, however, be sent to Govt. of India by the implementing Department/ agency immediately.
- vii) The "Scheme for Comprehensive Sugarcane Development under RKVY for the Year 2013-14" shall be extended to all the Sugarcane Districts in the State and the subsidy/ incentive shall be limited to the ceiling of ₹ 1,500 per acre. However, the component of 'Mini Sugarcane Harvester' is substituted with 'Wide bed—cum—Trench Planter, Subsoiler and Sugarcane Planter' on the request dated 6.6.2013 received from SUGARFED within the original budget provision. The Sugarcane section of the Department shall submit the revised project proposal at the earliest.
- viii) The project "for setting up of hi-tech labs for study of ground water contamination & its quality monitoring and strengthening of grid observation network in ground water cell of agriculture department for development, management & regulation of ground water resources" was approved in principle.
