**Minutes of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 to consider the projects under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) Stream –I for 2013-14**

Meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) was held on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2013 at Bhopal under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Government of Madhya Pradesh to consider the projects under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) for 2013-14 under Stream- I. The list of participants is at **Annexure – D**

The Committee discussed the agenda points and projects proposed for the year 2013-14 in the light of observation made by GOI and circulated to state Government vide letter no. 1-14/2013-RKVY dated 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2013. Decisions on each of the item are as follows:

**AGENDA**

**1. Review of expenditure during 2012-13**

The committee reviewed the status of expenditure during 2012-13 and expressed its satisfaction.

**2. Ex-post –facto approval of various projects sanctioned during the year 2012-13**

The committee approved all the projects which were sanctioned by the chief secretary in anticipation of the approval of the SLSC during 2012-13 along with the project shown in the Ex-agenda for nutri-cereal sub scheme. The lists of projects along with the amendments made there in are at **Annexure – A.**

**3. Proposed project for the year 2013-14**

The committee discussed all the projects in the light of tentative allocation received from GOI for the year 2013-14. The list of proposals approved and various observations made by the committee are at **Annexure – B.**



**Agenda –B:- Approval of annual plan 2013-14 of Extension Reforms (ATMA)**

In pursuance of the new guideline of Agriculture Technology Management Agency (ATMA) project, the committee considered the work plan for the year 2013-14 worth Rs 7142.76 lakh and accorded the approval.

**Agenda -C:- Any other issues with the permission of chairman**

- A. The proposal of utilizing 1% administrative charges were discussed in the meeting. This amount would be distributed as follows:
- a. 20% would be sanctioned from the state level.
  - b. 40% would be available at the respective directorates.
  - c. 40% would be made available to the districts to utilize as per RKVY norms.

1% of the allocation given to each department would be available to them to meet various expenditure which are of administrative nature.

- B. The committee also approved that 1% of the allocation for the year 2013-14 would be utilized to undertake evaluations of various project activities done under RKVY.

**Agenda -D:- Ex-Agenda Items:**

The committee discussed the four proposals and approved them. The list of approved proposals is at Annexure-C.



## OTHER DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE COMMITTEE:

### **Ex-post facto proposals:**

1. Project for the survey and modification in the Agriculture Statistics:  
Approved with the direction that the update on expenditure may be indicated in the next 7 days. (Item No.5)
2. Project for the study compilation and collection of all relevant acts, rules and regulation applicable in Agriculture Consortium:  
Approved. The various acts be put on the websites for easy access to various departments. (Item No.6)
3. Approved Project on Distribution of Spiral Grader in 20000 villages:  
The committee directed that the seed treatment drums should also be made available in villages where Van Adhikar Patra under the Forest Rights Act have been granted by forest department. (Item No.8)
4. Project to support farmers having Van Adhikar Patra under the Forest Rights Act:  
While approving the proposal, it was also decided that it would be implemented through agriculture department. (Item No.7)
5. Horticulture department should modify the Badi programme of vegetable cultivation so that it is aligned to fulfill the nutritional food needs of the mid-day-meal program. The revised proposal may be slightly expanded and linked with the self-help groups of the rural development department so that it is aligned with the mid-day-meal programme.  
  
Horticulture department should draw up a programme for vegetable cultivation in the select villages so that the farmers/self-help groups are able to get vegetables in all the seasons.
6. (A) In areas where irrigated crops are taken in kharif, agriculture department should make an effort to saturate such areas with paddy in the coming season. Necessary planning be started in such areas. Some of these areas are Harsi (Gwalior), Sanjai Sarovar and Barna Command. Wherever water for irrigation is available, the third crop for next summer should also be planned. In such commands summer *Gram* and *Moong* should also be considered.





(B) A study should also be done as to why farmers in Balaghat are not taking non-paddy crops.

7. Development of local entrepreneurs for farm machinery be undertaken by the Director, Agriculture Engineering. The support of Commerce & Industries Department in respect of making various incentives available, should also be carried out.
8. The committee was apprised that all proposals submitted before the SLSC have been duly scrutinized by the Directorate and the Principal Secretaries of the Department. All such proposals have also been scrutinized by the APC.

**Directions in respect of New Proposals:**

9. Project of Subsidy on Seed Distribution Programme: (Item no.1)  
Approved. The committee directed that the mandatory percentage under Head 41 & 64 for seed subsidy in 2013-14 should be ensured.
10. Project on Popularization of Hybrid Maize: (Item no.2)  
Approved. All the Primitive Tribal Groups would also be extended this benefit.
11. Project on Composite Nursery Raising For SRI: (Item no.3)  
Approved. The committee directed that the Adhikar Patra holders in forest areas should also be extended the benefit of this project.
12. Project on Nizer (Ramtil) Development Programme in District Dindori Madhya Pradesh: (Item no.6)  
The reason for poor area expansion of Ramtil in Madhya Pradesh in Scheduled Tribe areas is a cause of concern and the department should make efforts in this direction. It was decided that the rate norms available for ISOPOM would be adopted for this crop. The program regarding expansion of Ramtil in interior areas should be explored.  
Vice Chancellor, JNKVV, Jabalpur apprised the Committee with the availability of 5 Quintal of Ramtil seeds which can be used for seed multiplication program.
13. Integrated Development of Agriculture in the areas of primitives tribes of Saharia, Bega and Bharia in Sheopur, Dindori and Chhindwara district respectively: (Item no.8)



It was directed that Shivpuri should also be added in the project. The department would ensure that the project benefits would be available to all Primitive Tribal Groups irrespective of whether they are located within the district limit or not.

14. Project on Clustered Demonstration of Gwar in Shivpuri, Gwalior and Morena District: (Item no.9)

Approved with the direction that Bhind would also be added in the project. Project cost was also revised to Rs.100 lakhs.

15. Proposal for Promotion and Strengthening of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) in Madhya Pradesh to establish agriculture based livelihood initiatives, market integration and effective extension and value addition services by SFAC: (Item no.10)

The committee directed that district mapping exercise be undertaken for Farmer Producer Organizations in the state. APC would do the necessary coordination with Rural Development, Agriculture, Horticulture and other agencies in this respect.

16. Project on Popularization of Seed Treatment: (Item no.13)

The committee advised that seed treatment and spiral graders should also be given to various farmer producer organisations actively working in Madhya Pradesh. These organizations have strong demonstrative arrangements and they can make good use of spiral graders and seed treating drum. Watershed committees should also be considered on the same line.

17. Project on Public Private Partnership for Integrated Agriculture Development under RKVY in Madhya Pradesh: (Item no.14)

Approved with the direction that while designing the project the RKVY norms for public private partnership in agriculture development should be followed.

Principal Secretary Water Resources Department suggested that they would like to undertake one such program in 5000 ha. He would prepare a project in 30 days and its DPR would be submitted to the Chief Secretary for approval. A token provision of Rs.5 crores is also allocated.

18. Project on Strengthening of Agriculture Extension & Training Centres: (Item no.16)

Approved with the condition that all these training centres would be transferred to SIATE. The project would be undertaken in two years with an allocation of Rs.10 crore for each year.



19. It was also decided that Water Resources Department would prepare an integrated project in command area and furnish the detail in next 30 days. Agriculture Production Commissioner would do the necessary coordination with other stake holders. An allocation of Rs.5 crore would be provided to Water Resources Department for this project.
20. Principal Secretary Agriculture apprised the committee in respect of project for construction of micro irrigation tank by Agriculture Department. The proposal is being finalized by the Agriculture Department for submission before the Cabinet. A tentative allocation of Rs.10 crore is earmarked for this project.
- 21 Project for the incentivisation to farmers for purchase of Ridge and Furrow attachment:  
In respect of item number 3.2.1/ 3.2.2/ 3.2.3 and 3.2.4 relating to seed treating drum, spiral graders, conoweeder marker and ridge and furrow attachment, it was decided that 50% of each of the project would be allocated to MARKFED and M.P. Agro Industries Development Corporation.
- 22 .Construction of Protected Cultivation Corridor on the Indore Bhopal Highway: (Item no.3.4.1)  
Director Horticulture emphasized the need of insurance in this project area. He also told the committee that this structure would be maintained for three years and the process is being done through an open transparent tender system. It was decided that aggregation and post production issues would also be addressed in this project. The need of FPO for horticulture farmers and the necessary backward and forward linkages that need to be developed should also be kept in mind.
- 23 Principal Secretary Fisheries requested the need of bicycle for fishermen. The committee approved the project as submitted by the department.
- 24 Approval of the pattern proposed for distributing award out of the amount received in Krishi Karman Award: In respect of the approval of Rs.2 crore, received on account of Krishi Karman Award, it was decided that it will be separately submitted to the Chief Secretary and his approval would be taken.(Ex-agenda item no.2.3)
- 25 The year-wise split up of allocation for each scheme shall be indicated and this amount should be such that it could be spent in the given time frame.




- 26 The year-wise split of allocation should also indicate how many projects are new and how many are carry over of the past years.
- 27 All farmer centric demonstration should be taken in clusters only. And such clusters would not be less than 100 ha. as stipulated in the Ministry of Agriculture norms. The location of such clusters should be shown on a digital map of the area.
- 28 .Where district level targets are to be given, these should be finalized before the start of the projects. The technique of demonstration should also be stabilized.
- 29 The Agriculture Production Commissioner would release indicative allocation to all departments and ask for their revised projects in 7 days time.
- 30 It was agreed that wherever ATMA fund is available for any of the activity proposed in the projects, an attempt would be made to utilize full allocation under ATMA on priority basis.
- 31 Keeping in view the paucity of certified seed of recommended varieties, T.L. seed of the same varieties was permitted to be used in Nutri Farm and Nutri cereal sub schemes.
- 32 An exhaustive discussion was held on RADP sub scheme. In view of the observation made by RFS division of MOA, GoI, it has been decided to recast and implement the sub schemes with high level of convergence and integration with other schemes in the selected areas.
- From next year all the department under agriculture consortium will be involved to prepare the project plan for eligible districts.
- 33.The AFDP project has been designed around small and marginal farmers who have small holdings which may become a bottleneck. The proposal need to be re-designed so that farmers who have adequate land are also incorporated in the project. The project should be taken up in clusters only. The revised project would be separately submitted to the Chief Secretary for approval.
34. During the discussion in the meeting regarding fast development of dairy sector, the committee agreed to allocate a token provision of Rs 100.00 lakhs each for the project of new Dairy development plant at Rewa and Strengthening the packaging/ chilling centre at Singrauli. These project will be prepared and submitted to Agriculture Production Commissioner within 7 days time.

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35. All departments and agencies would revise their proposals in the light of above observations and resubmit them within 7 days to the Agriculture Production Commissioner.
