Minutes of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting on RKVY for 2013-14 held on 30-09-2013 at Chief Secretary's Conference Hall at 10.00 AM, Kohima Nagaland.

Meeting Agenda:-

- Review of RKVY progress report in the State during 2012-13 by 9 Agri & allied departments by power point presentation.
- Approval of Action Plan for 2013-14.

Minutes of the 1st Agenda.

- 1. The meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Nagaland, Shri. Alemtemshi Jamir, IAS.
- 2. The meeting was attended by all Administrative Heads, State Planning Department, State Finance Department & Head of the Departments of 9 (Nine) Agri & Allied departments participating in RKVY in the State. The Forest Department joined the meeting.
- 3. Shri, Manesh Choudhury, Dy. Adviser (Agri), from Planning Commission of India and Shri, Sarvesh Rai, Director (Trade) from the DAC, New Delhi represented Govt. of India.
- 4. The Chairman & Chief Secretary warmly welcomed the participants with brief introduction of the RKVY-SLSC being held for the State, and further asked the Member-Secretary, Shri. N.Benjamin Newmai, Secretary of Agriculture, Govt. of Nagaland to initiate the review on progress reports of RKVY-2012-13.
- 5. The power point presentation review on progress report of RKVY was given by 9 (nine) agri & allied departments.
- 6. While reviewing, it is seen that the allocation of RKVY to the State for the year 2013-14 by DAC was Rs. 51.90 Crores, which is 40 % less as compared to the last year- 2012-13 allocation of Rs. 85.75 Crores, and 23.10 crores short of the amount earmarked by the Planning Commission of India. It was observed that the Planning Commission of India has earmarked Rs. 75.00 Crores for the current year 2013-14, as confirmed by the PCI, GOI representative Shri. Manesh Choudhury in the meeting. The State Planning Department has finalized an amount of Rs. 75.00 crores for RKVY under ACA during the current year 2013-14 as agreed upon by the Planning Commission of India during the final Plan

discussion between the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Nagaland and Dy. Chairman, Planning Commission, GOI, New Delhi. The shortfall allocation to the tune of Rs. 23.10 Crores is affecting the overall State Plan size of the year 2013-14.

7. Therefore, after thorough deliberations, the Chairman & Chief Secretary stated that the SLSC can neither overrule nor is competent to change the State Plan size already decided. Hence, the SLSC unanimously decided to approve Rs.75.00 crores as allocation for RKVY for the year 2013-14. It was also decided, while awaiting total allocation as earmarked, to approve the Action Plan prepared by the 9 (nine) Agri & Allied departments based on the present allocation made by the DAC for an amount of Rs.51.90 crores. The Nodal Department is advised to pursue with DAC, New Delhi for allocation of the remaining amount.

2. Action Plan 2013-14.

- 1. The Action Plan for 2013-14 prepared by 9 (nine) agri & allied departments were placed before the House for approval.
- 2. The Action Plan -2013-14 for Agriculture Department (Nodal department) with 18 (eighteen) projects/schemes under Normal and RADP under Sub-scheme, was approved taking into consideration the cessation of MMA programmes and the task of achieving Vision 2025, Food for All.
- 3. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Horticulture department with 7(seven) projects/schemes under Normal and 7(seven) components under Sub-scheme (VIUC) was taken as approved with the comments that the department revised the action plan in consonance with guidelines & observation made by the DAC.
- 4. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Fishery Department with 4(four) projects/schemes under Normal and 2(two) components under Sub-scheme(NMPS) was taken as approved with the suggestion from Shri, Manesh Choudhury, Dy. Adviser (Agri) (PCI) to take care of cage culture, and further advised the department to convincingly work out per-capita consumption. Also advised to follow guidelines specially in the implementation of NMPS.
- 5. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Vety & AH with 4(four) projects/schemes under Normal and 1(one) component under Sub-scheme (NMPS) as (Pig.Dev) was taken as approved with the following suggestions and comments from Shri, Sarvesh Rai, Director (Trade) DAC, to follow the cost norms as mentioned in the observations of DAC. And not to deviate from guidelines as far as possible.

- 6. The Chairman & Chief Secretary made a mentioned on how was the existing policy & programmes pertaining to Embryo import in case of Milch cow for enhancing Milk production. The house had deliberated on the issue with clarifications from the department and the Chairman accordingly suggested the department to examine the possibilities feasibility in the State.
- 7. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Soil & Water Conservation department with 4(four) projects/schemes under Normal was approved.
- 8. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Land Resources department with 2(two) projects/schemes under Normal was taken as approved with the condition that the Rubber plantation is replaced by other components feasible in the State. The Director (Trade) pointed out that there are other programmes available for rubber and should not be taken up under RKVY, and mentioned of the objection raised in the previous occasion. The Department agreed to abide by the guidelines.
- 9. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Sericulture with 3(three) projects/schemes under Normal was approved.
- 10. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Co-operation department with 3 (three) projects/schemes was taken as approved. However, the Chairman & Chief Secretary noted the absence of senior officers from the department.
- 11. The Action Plan-2013-14 for Irrigation & Flood Control Department with 1(one) project/scheme under Normal was taken as approved. Director (Trade) Shri, Sarvesh Rai, expressed his opinion that Irrigation &FC dept. may avail fund from other sources like Water Resources Ministry where several programmes are available like AIBP etc, instead of RKVY and suggested for exclusion from RKVY.
- 12. The Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forest Department, Nagaland requested the SLSC for consideration of Agro-forestry scheme/project under RKVY, which being very relevant in the State. The Chairman & Chief Secretary appreciated the keenness of the Department and assured to explore the possibility of under RKVY in future.

13. The Chairman suggested for more meeting of RKVY in future and concluded with thanks to all the participants.
