Proceedings of the meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) for RKVY held on 25th July 2013, at 1.00 p.m in the Conference Hall of Manan Bhawan.

The Meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) for Rashtriya Krishi Vikash Yojana (RKVY) was convened in the conference hall of New secretariat on 25th July 2013 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Government of Sikkim. The meeting was attended by the Secretary Planning cum Development Commissioner, Shree N.K.Gupta Dy. Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India and other members of the Committee. The list of the members attending the meeting is enclosed.

1. At the outset, the Secretary FS&ADD/ Member Secretary of SLSC offered a warm welcome to Hon'ble Chairperson and other members of the Committee. In his introductory remarks he informed the house that the main objective behind launching of RKVY was to achieve 4% growth in Agriculture sector and to incentivise the States for more investment in this sector. He further informed the house about the allocation of normal RKVY fund during 2013-14 which is Rs.8.75 Crore , much less than expected. He also informed the house about the non release of 2nd instalment by Govt. of India for both normal RKVY as well as its Sub-Schemes during 2012-13 and stated that the allocation of 2013-14 will be utilized to complete the ongoing projects approved during 2012-13. The Pr. Director FS&ADD/ State Nodal Officer RKVY presented the progress of 2012-13 and Shelves of Projects for 2013-14.
2. The presentation clearly indicated the fund allocation for 2012-13, its release and project wise expenditure. Further, he also stressed upon committed liabilities of 2012-13 which need to be provided from the allocation of 2013-14 for both normal RKVY as well as Sub -Schemes. He also stated that Shelves of Projects for 2013-14 was sent to Govt. of India for their comment and consideration.
3. During the discussion Chief Secretary directed to intimate Secretary Animal Husbandry while implementing Integrated Farming System under Rainfed Area Development Programme for taking up Livestock based farming system and Fishery based farming system in addition to involvement of district official which is in practice at present.

4. Regarding Fisheries, Secretary Animal Husbandry informed the house that Floating Cage Culture for Rainbow Trout has been initiated at Kupup and Memecho. Aquaculture Development through Integrated approach which is a beneficiaries oriented programme was taken up in 200 units. He further informed that there was a great scope of Trout Fish Farming in the State, Trout Fish being sold at Rs.800 per Kg. The Chief Secretary directed Secretary AH to make Sribadam a Trout Farming Village as per the instruction of Hon'ble Chief Minister.
5. Shri N.K. Gupta, Dy. Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, GOI also suggested to complete the ongoing projects of 2012-13 from allocation of 2013-14. He was also informed about the very little allocation during 2013-14 and was requested to look into to this. In his reply he stated that the DAC do not make allocation as it was the Planning Commission who makes the allocation.
6. The Development Commissioner informed that Rs.20.00 Crore was finalized under RKVY and accordingly size of the Plan was finalized. Hence, if the actual allocation was only Rs.8.75 Crore, that will affect our plan size which will not be accepted and should be dealt with seriously. Therefore, she stressed upon allocation of balance amount of Rs.11.25 Crore by Govt. of India. She asked the Department to put up a note along with the allocation paper from Govt. of India. Shri N.K. Gupta provided comments of Govt. of India for the shelves of projects and stated that all the projects are supported but should follow guidelines and norms of Govt. of India.
7. The Secretary FS&ADD further stated that the performance of the Department vis.a.vis the allocation under Allied Agriculture Sectors was so impressive that the Department was expecting an allocation to the tune of Rs.25.00 Crore, but to the dismay of everyone the allocation of only Rs.8.75 Crore was received paralyzing the schemes envisaged under the scheme. To make the matter worse, he further stated, the Macro Management in Agriculture (MMA) was discontinued by GOI during CFY. As it was a major source of funding the programme under Agriculture Sector, its abrupt discontinuation severely hit the programmes leaving the state without any fund to take up the programme in agriculture.

8. The Chief Secretary appreciated the gravity of the situation and asked Mr. Gupta to take up the matter in the Ministry and apprise the authorities of the dire situation.
9. Non release of 2nd instalment of 2012-13 and poor allocation during 2013-14 was seriously viewed by the Chief Secretary and requested Govt. of India through their representative to release balance amount of Rs.6.00 Crore of last financial year and allocate Rs.11.25 Crore in addition to Rs.8.75 Crore for the financial year 2013-2014 as Rs.20.00 Crore is included in the total plan size of the state.
10. The MD, Sikkim Co-operative Milk Producer Union requested for inclusion of new project ***Oestrus Synchronization & Controlled Breeding of Dry Dairy Cows to enhance Milk Production in Sikkim*** in Shelves of new project of RKVY 2013-14.

The Chairman SLSC supported the proposal and asked to include in the Shelves of Projects. She also directed that the Capacity building of milk farmers should be taken care of by Sikkim Milk Union Gangtok rather than in isolation by districts. She also directed the Sikkim Milk Union, North District should also be given guidance and support by the MD Sikkim Milk Union, Gangtok.

11. The Director, State Agriculture Management & Extension Training Institute (SAMETI) apprised about the mandate of SAMETI & Agriculture Technology Management Agency (ATMA) and presented the progress report of Extension Reforms 2012-13 and State Extension Work Plan (SEWP) 2013-14. Secretary Animal Husbandry stressed that the official from their Department and farmers taking up Animal Husbandry should also be sent to exposure visit outside the state by SAMETI. The Secretary, FS&ADD requested ICAR for assistance in research of Organic Farming and Joint Director ICAR readily agreed to extend all possible help from his end.
12. The Chief Secretary & Development Commissioner also expressed their desire to participate in one of the training organized by SAMETI. As it would be an honour, they will be invited in one of the training programme organized by SAMETI as per their convenience.
13. The Development Commissioner wanted educated farmers /youths to be included in the exposure visit so that they may learn and replicate the same

when they are back home in the State to take up agriculture as commercial venture.

14. Since there was no more queries the SLSC accorded approval for :

This relates to implementation of programme under RKVY during 2013-14. The details of physical & financial progress of various projects approved & sanctioned during 2012-13 has been reflected vide nsp 97-100 and shelves of new projects vide nsp 100-101.

During the financial year 2012-13, Govt of India released only 50% of fund under normal RKVY as well as sub -schemes. Hence, it is proposed to complete the ongoing projects of 2012-13 from the allocation of 2013-14 which is as under:-
