
Sub:- **Minutes of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting for RKVY 2019-20 held at the Conference Hall of the SLSC Chairman & Chief Secretary, Nagaland on 15.03.2019 at 10:30 A.M.**

The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting for RKVY 2019-20 was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Shri. Temjen Toy. The meeting was attended by the State Planning & Coordination Department, Finance Department, members of the Administrative Heads of Departments and Heads of the Department of Agri & Allied Departments including the 3(Three) Missions along with Programme Officers of Agri & Allied Departments.

The Chairman welcomed all members of the SLSC and requested the Agriculture Production Commissioner, Nagaland Shri. T. Imkonglemba Ao to present the agendas and initiate the proposals for the meeting. The APC introduced the Govt. of India representative Shri. Anand Krishan, Joint Director, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare, New Delhi to the members of the SLSC. He thanked the Govt. of India for the timely release of funds in the ongoing projects for all the Agri & Allied Department in the State particularly RKVY which is an important programme for gap filling for income generation for the farmers. The APC expressed his appreciation to the State Planning & Finance Department on behalf of the Agri & Allied Departments for releasing the State matching share along with the Central releases.

The APC requested the RKVY State Nodal Officer-2 Shri. Letkholal Hangsing, Joint Director to give a brief review of RKVY implementation for 2018-19. Following comments were made:


1. The Chairman reviewed the RKVY implementation Department wise and the SLSC was satisfied with the performance of the programme implementation.
2. The Chairman stressed importance on the implementation and development of Soil Health in the State and requested the APC to convene a meeting of the Agriculture and Soil & Water Conversation Department with the Chief Secretary.
3. On the query by the Additional Chief Secretary & Development Commissioner in regard to Bamboo Development in the State, the APC stated that 88.30% of the total geographical area of the State belongs to the community, clan and the individuals and the Nagaland Bamboo Development Agency has taken up extensive bamboo plantation in this community, clan, private land as well as additive value addition where integrated agriculture activities are being taken up by the Departments.
4. The Chairman encouraged the SLSC members and the Departments present that the various Departments in the State should work with one mission which should be convergence.
5. The APC informed the SLSC members that for the approval of the RKVY Action Plan, the State Level Technical Screening Committee (SLTSC) under the Chairmanship of

APC initially examines and recommends each of the Department proposals, which is again scrutinized by the line Divisions in the Ministry during the Pre-SLSC (which was held on 13th March 2019 in New Delhi) and the comments and observation of the Pre-SLSC is brought to the State Level Sanctioning Committee for final recommendation and approval.

With the approval of the Chairman the Annual Action Plan for RKVY 2019-2020 was taken up for discussion.

6. The SLSC agreed that the State Nodal Department, i.e, the Department of Agriculture will release its sanction based on the basis of releases made by the Government of India. The implementation of RKVY schemes by the stake holding Agri & Allied Department must be as per sanction released made by the Govt. of India.
7. The release of fund for RKVY for the year 2019-2020 will be made for the schemes that are approved by the SLSC. Priority will be made for the schemes approved for each Department within the recommended amount of Rs.50.00 crores for the year 2019-20. In other words, the releases will be made as per Govt. of India approved outlay, then the schemes which are recommended within 50.00 crores by SLSC. The other schemes, if may, will be taken up as additionality, subject to consideration of Govt. of India.
8. The Agriculture Joint Director, incharge of RKVY apprised the SLSC members that the State Level Technical Screening Committee has recommended the Annual Action Plan 2019-20 amounting to Rs. 50,00,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Crores) only. The comments and views of the Pre-SLSC for Annual Action Plan were taken up for discussion and recommendation which is mentioned below:-
 - i. **Agriculture Department:-** The RKVY Annual Action Plan of Agriculture Department was thoroughly discussed taking into consideration the comments of the Pre-SLSC. The committee has urged the Agriculture Department to complete the Geo-tagging at the earliest. Further for the Agri-Clinic & Agri Business component the SLSC recommended for empanelment of the School of Agricultural Sciences and Rural Development, (SASRD) Medziphema, Nagaland (under the Nagaland Central University and accredited by the Indian Council Agriculture Research, ICAR), instead of Agriculture University, Jorhat, Asom. This recommendation is made taking into consideration of the cost effectiveness, short distance travel and also exposure of the Agriculture Students in the University. The Committee approved the proposal of the Agriculture Department to an amount of Rs.2156.00 (Twenty-one crores fifty-six Lakhs) only (Action Plan enclosed).
 - ii. **Horticulture Department:-** The RKVY Annual Action Plan of Horticulture was examined by the SLSC and directed the Department to submit the information as sought by the Ministry during the Pre-SLSC at the earliest. The proposal of Horticulture Department amounting to Rs. 300.00/- (Three hundred Lakhs) was approved by the SLSC (Action Plan enclosed).
 - iii. **Veterinary & AH Department:-** The Veterinary & AH Department informed the SLSC that the proposal for implementation of Community Pig Farm was dropped during the Pre-SLSC meeting on 13th March 2019. The SLSC after detail deliberation was of the


- view that the State is still facing pork meat deficit which is supplemented by import from outside the State. The SLSC therefore recommended for Pig breeding in cluster areas (in-situ) where the agriculture waste can be used as feed for the animals. After necessary rectification of the proposal, it was approved to an amount of Rs. 380.00 Lakhs (Action Plan enclosed).
- iv. **Fishery Department:-** The project proposal of the Fishery Department was deliberated and requested the Department to provide the location along with Geo-tagging and the Action plan amounting to Rs. 300.00 Lakhs was approved by the SLSC (Action Plan enclosed).
 - v. **Soil & Water Conservation Department:-** The proposal for Bench Terracing and the comments of the Pre-SLSC of the Soil & Water Conservation were deliberated, and the SLSC approved the proposal amounting to Rs. 400.00 Lakhs (Action Plan enclosed).
 - vi. **Land Resources Development Department:-** The proposal for spring shed based watershed management and capacity building and training of the Department was approved by the Committee amounting to Rs. 150.00 Lakhs
 - vii. **Co-operation Department:-** The Co-operation Department's project proposal for formation of CIG along with other projects was approved by the SLSC amounting to Rs. 150.00 Lakhs.
 - viii. **Sericulture Department:-** The proposal of the Sericulture Department for gap filling in the farmers field for doubling of farmer's income was discussed thoroughly. The Chairman further advised the Department to also give importance to quality of product so that a niche market can be created. The Committee approved the proposal to an amount of Rs. 150.00 Lakhs.
 - ix. The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) after detailed deliberation approved the proposals of the following Missions:
 - x. **Nagaland Bamboo Development Agency:-** The APC informed the SLSC that the Nagaland Bamboo Development Agency (NBDA) is carrying out the Bamboo Plantation in the Community, Clan and private land as value addition in the farmer's field and to help develop entrepreneurship for the farmers. The proposal amounting to Rs. 75.00 Lakhs which was approved by the Committee.
 - xi. **Nagaland Beekeeping and Honey Mission:-** The Annual Action Plan of Nagaland Bee and Honey Mission (NBHM) with the objective of providing additive income to the farmers by providing bee boxes and other logistic support in the farmer's field was deliberated and approved by the Committee for an amount of Rs.75.00 Lakhs.
 - xii. **Nagaland Bio-Resources Mission:** The project proposal of the Bio-Resource Mission, for the development of Agro Medicinal and Aromatic viable plants native to the State and which are not listed in the Ayush medicinal list was approved to an amount of Rs. 75.00 Lakhs.

- xiii. **IFAD-FOCUS Convergence:-** The point raised during the Pre-SLSC was clarified by FOCUS/IFAD stating that in the Design Completion Report prepared by the IFAD and the Government of Nagaland, it was agreed that the Government of Nagaland will transfer the estimated budget chargeable to the Mission from the Centrally Sponsored Schemes including State share, and the Mission will submit the utilization and progress report to the Nodal Department (Agriculture). The SLSC deliberated on the matter and was of the opinion that there is no parallel funding. The proposal of FOCUS-IFAD was approved by the Committee amounting to Rs. 400.00 Lakhs.
- xiv. **Nagaland State Agriculture Marketing Board:-** The proposal of Nagaland State Marketing Board (NSAMB) for strengthening of all the APMCs infrastructures in the Districts was approved by the Committee amounting to Rs. 250.00 Lakhs.

Other Agendas taken up by the SLSC.

- i) The SLSC deliberated on the additional project proposals submitted by the Agri & Allied Departments and the proposals were agreed in principle subject to recommendation by the State Level Technical Screening Committee **during May 2019** for resubmission to SLSC.
- ii) The members of SLSC have requested all the Agri & Allied Departments not to duplicate the programmes in the same areas but rather share the resources and infrastructures that are already available.
- iii) The SLSC took note of letter NO. AGR/RKVY -1/47/2018 Dated the 27th February 2019 submitted by the Nodal Department of RKVY to the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare (RKVY Division) with regard to the matter of instances where Allied Departments have been submitting proposals under RKVY-RAFTAAR directly to the Ministry without routing it through the Nodal Department i.e., Agriculture Department. It was further noted that such cases hampers the smooth functioning and implementation of RKVY scheme. It was impressed upon all allied departments that the Nodal Department shall not be responsible for any lapses/irregularities which may occur for proposals which are forwarded to the Ministry without the recommendation of the State Level Sanctioning Committee. The SLSC also reaffirmed letter No.1-19/2019-RKVY Dated 13th March 2019 written by the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare in reply to the letter submitted by the Nodal Department of the State wherein the Ministry has pointed out that all Agri & Allied Departments must follow RKVY-RAFTAAR Operational Guidelines of 2017-18 to 2019-20.
- iv) The Various schemes under Agri & Allied Departments amounting to Rs 50.00 crores as recommended by the State Level Technical Screening Committee shall be taken up on priority. In the event of getting less allocation from Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, proportionate pro-rata decrease/ will be made for all the Agri & Allied Departments including Missions that are recommended under RKVY for the year 2019-20.

- v) Quarterly Progress Reports for the Month ending June/September/December and March for the year 2019-20 along with Utilization Certificates against the fund released during the period must be mandatorily done by the implementing department without which the next release to that department will be withheld.

The Chairman concluded the meeting with thanks to all the members and representatives.
